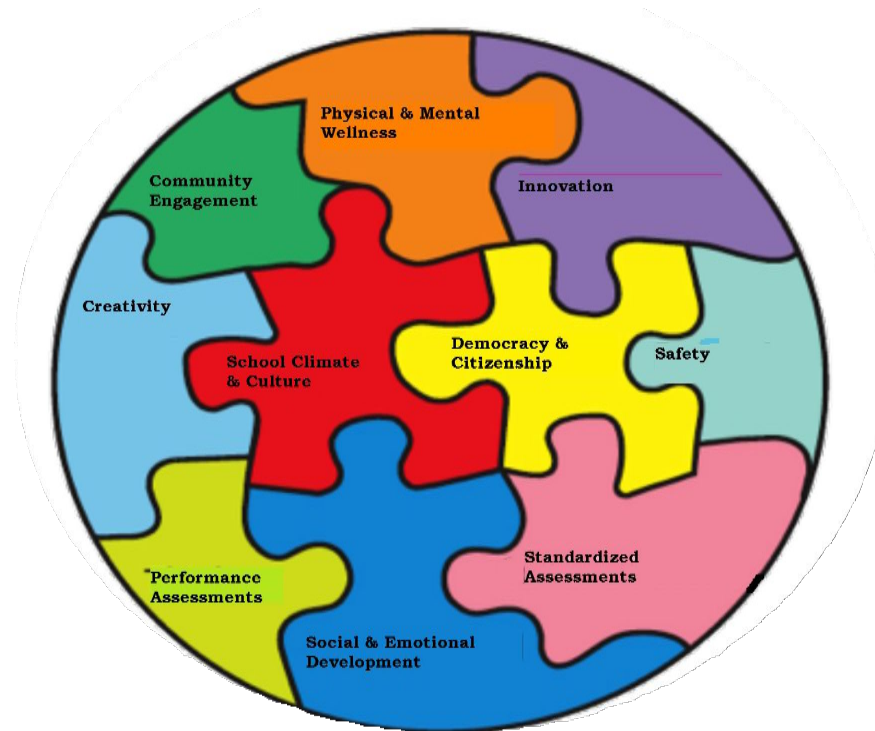

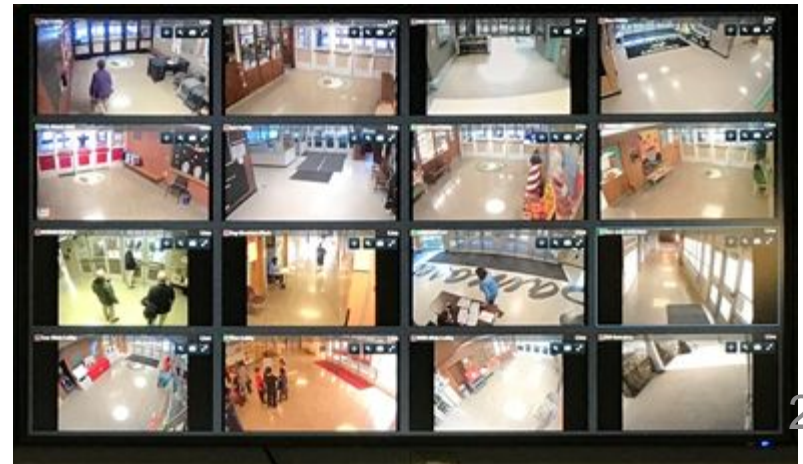

# Security Guards in Vestibules

**A Security Guard has training, knowledge, skills, and abilities that better prepare them for this important safety function and initial line of defense.**

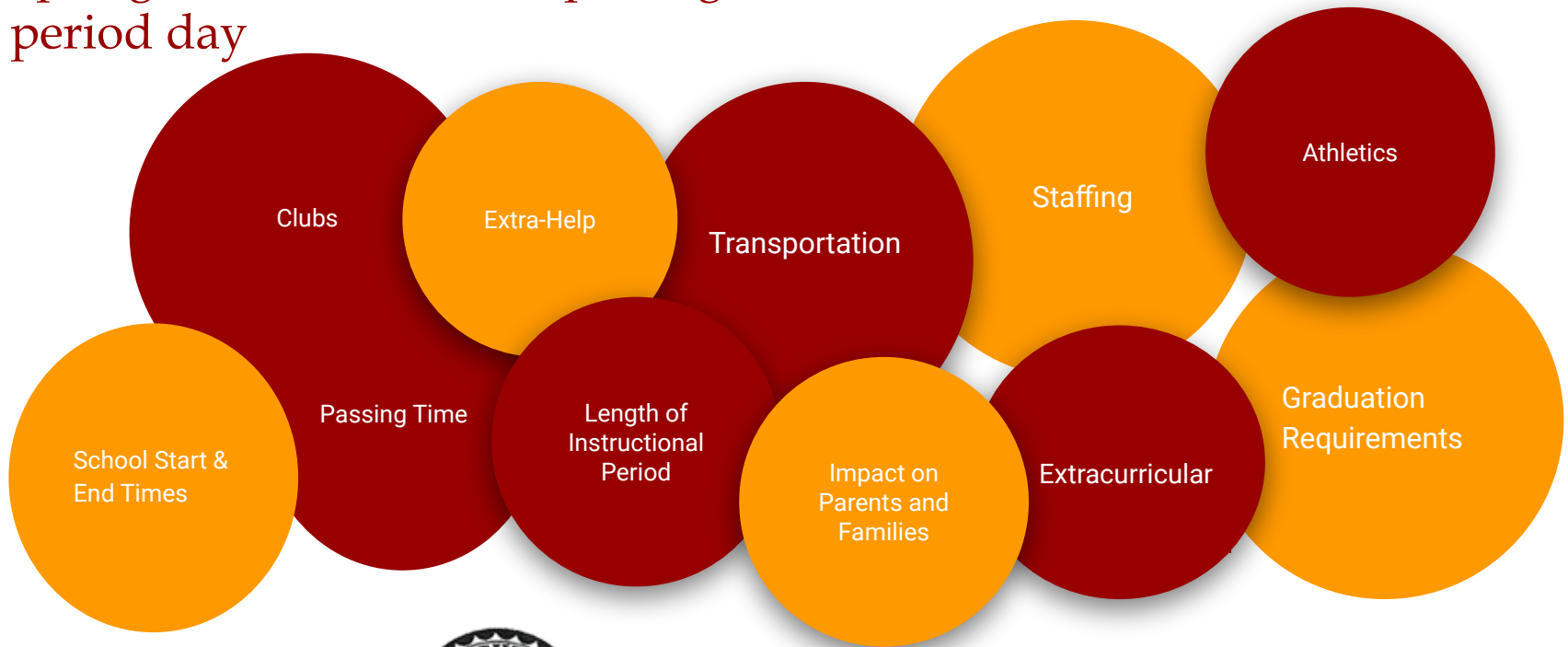
- Required to take an 8-hour “pre-assignment” training course, which they must complete and pass prior to applying to the NYS Department of State for a Security Guard License.
- Within the first 90 days of employment, they must complete an additional 16 hours of on-the-job training.
- Every year thereafter they need to complete 8 hours of additional “maintenance” training to keep their license valid.
- They are trained to assist administration and staff during all types of emergencies and disturbances.
  - **Such as:** Lockdowns/Lockouts/Evacuations, threat assessments, de-escalation techniques, radio & panic button utilization, interactions with police and first responders, visitor management, and camera utilization.

- The District’s Security Command Center currently has nine 50” monitors with sixteen camera views.
- As we continue with our districtwide security upgrades, each vestibule will also be fitted with a monitor so that the building guard can view activity throughout the building and property.



# 9-Period Day Exploration
