Teachers from various disciplines inspiring students to us specific skills and processes to explore what they learn more deeply, solve problems in innovative ways and create new things.




#### The Four Cs: Communication, Collaboration, Creativity, Critical Thinking

Formerly known as "21st Century Skills," The Four Cs help students be more engaged in their lessons, learn to work together more effectively and tackle challenges in ways that reflect the modern workplace.

## Preparing Students for College, Careers, Citizenship, and Life

A major study (Conley, 2005) of what it takes to succeed in entry-level college courses found the following general "habits of mind" to be key, along with subject-specific knowledge and skills:

- ▶ Critical-thinking skills
- ► Analytical-thinking skills
- ▶ Problem-solving skills
- ▶ Open to and utilizes critical feedback
- ▶ Open to possible failures at times
- ▶ Clear and convincing written and oral expression
- ► Can weigh sources for importance and credibility
- ► Can draw inferences and reach conclusions independently
- ▶ Time management skills


