Details of Camp Sachem

Current

- 2 Programs (PreK-4, 5-7)
- July-2 Sessions at 9 days, 8:30-2:30
- 75 Students
- Directors, 2 Lead Counselors
- Various Classes-Top Chef, 3D Printing, Crossfit, Robotics, Legos, Math Madness, etc.
- All Classes: 1 Certified Teacher, A Counselor, Max-15 Students
- Lunch (Bring Own-No Snack)
- All ordering, hiring, registration and class set up down in house

Food for Thought

- No longer offering child care
- Numbers dwindling
- Staff is limited
- Not currently offering assistance for special needs students



Summer 2016-2017 Costs and Gross

- Approximate Cost: \$495 per Student
- District Cost to Run: \$84,000
- Sachem Camp Net: \$78,000
- Currently the program requires *General Funds* to support its operation



Suggested: Camp Sachem by SCOPE

- Sessions Same but 8:30-4:30
- Enrichment Activities-AM-We Choose
- Lunch (Students bring)
- Exploratory Program/Care-PM, Snack Provided
- Supervisor, Lead Teachers, Aides
- ▶ 1:10 or 1:18 Ratio
- Salaries Same via SCOPE
- Materials and Curriculum Provided
- Hiring, Registration via Scope

Food for Thought

- SCOPE hires our staff first.
- All FCS childcare students can work/volunteer.
- Offer \$1500.00 scholarships to our students and graduates each year they work at SCOPE toward a college of their choosing.
