## History

- Safe Schools Against Violence in Education Act (SAVE)
  - Enacted July 24, 2000
- Commissioner's Regulation §155.17
  - · District-Wide Safety Plan
  - School Building Emergency Response Plans
  - Codes of Conduct
  - Child Abuse in an Educational Setting
  - · Fingerprinting Regulations
  - School Violence Prevention and Intervention

Superintendent of Schools is the District's **Chief Emergency Officer** 

- Education Law §807(1-a), b: Fire and Emergency Drills
  - Fire drills to include Emergency Drills
  - Twelve (12) Drills per year
    - Four (4) Lockdown
    - · Eight (8) Evacuation
  - Eight (8) of the Twelve (12) drills <u>must be completed</u>
     by **December 31**<sup>st</sup> of each year

## **Legislative Requirements**

Education Law §2801-a: School Safety Plans

## Includes, but not limited to:

- Policies and procedures for responding to implied or direct threats of violence.
- Designation of an Emergency Response Team.
- Appropriate prevention and intervention strategies.
- Policies and procedures for the safe evacuation of the school in the event of a serious violent incident or other emergency.
- Policies and procedures for contacting appropriate law enforcement officials.
- Policies and procedures for contacting parents or guardians in the event of a violent incident.
- Protocols for responding to bomb threats, hostagetakings, intrusions and kidnappings.

  - Health and Safety Committee
  - <u>Consists of</u>: District Administrators and Supervisors,
     Union Leaders, various Building Personnel, and a Board of Education member.
- SAVE Committee 10 Members
  - Sub-Committee of the School Safety Team
    - <u>Consists of</u>: District Administrators and Supervisors, SCTA & SAA Union Leaders, High School student representatives, and Board of Education members.
