
- ~Fully integrated Reading and Writing Units of Study
- ~Professional development and new teaching tools to support the science behind reading success
- ~Ensuring phonemic awareness and phonics instruction are systematic
- ~Software to support student engagement (gamified!) and differentiation
- ~Literacy data for multiple sources and PD to help teachers diagnose deficit areas
- ~Reading AIS, Resource Room and ENL teachers empowered with new tools

- ~ Added second period for 7th grade ELA classes to allow for small group instruction and to address deficit areas for students.
- ~ Collegial conversations with PD around Next Gen standards and updates to our Sachem reading and writing units of study (Literacy Matters)
- ~ Purchased new books for classroom libraries (leveled texts in multiple genres)
- ~ Increased focus on student choice in reading selections (independent practice)
- ~ New software purchases to support differentiation (NoRedInk, Newsela, Sora)
- ~ Professional development in best practices for small group instruction (Seeley, Read 180)

~Professional development and new tools for differentiation



- ~New book rooms with short text for different learner needs
- ~Struggling readers are supported with new tools such as Read 180 and/or Achieve 3000 using NWEA data
- ~Next Generation standards review and curriculum updates
- ~In 2022-23, Sachem had a passing rate of 89% on the English Regents exam. (NYS passing rate of 77%)

<u> AP Capstone Highlights – East</u>

82 students took AP Seminar last year. 95.1% earned a 3 or above. In NYS, 76.2% earned 3 or above. Globally: 84.6%.

Caroline Keegan is looking at the ocean's changing salinity due to climate change. Using resources from Stony Brook's Marine Studies Department, she is researching the damage caused by decreasing salinity using evidence found in affected shark teeth.

Autumn Danziger is working with Brookhaven Lab and Cold Spring Harbor on using mushrooms to consume environmental pollutants.

Michael Mauro, one of many over the past 3 years to achieve both the AP Seminar and Research Certificate and the AP Capstone Diploma, was recently accepted by Harvard University.

AP Capstone Highlights – North

Emma Polund was offered a research opportunity at SUNY Binghamton with her college acceptance.


Ashley Edgar received a perfect score on her AP Research exam.

Less than 2% of students nationwide receive a perfect score.

Ryan Desimone presented his research at a local rally, which was then delivered to Governor Hochul at the NYS assembly to help increase funding for agencies that service children and adults with special needs.

Andrew Metzger will be presenting his research to Northwell Health's trafficking department. He has connected with organizations on LI's east end so he can replicate his research on the farming industry here. He volunteers weekly at a local non-profit that helps trafficking victims.
