The activities reviewed key topics taught throughout the year thus far including figurative language, signposts, genre study, parts of speech and grammar.

Chippewa Elementary School recently hosted the Journeys Into American Indian Territory for its fourth graders. Students explored all aspects of Native American life. They interacted with artifacts during a museum presentation, played traditional games and listened to stories from the Native American culture, made clay bowls and participated in a workshop focusing on the Haudenosaunee government.
