

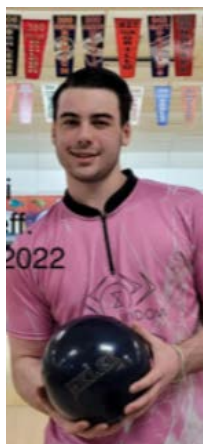

Sixth graders at Samoset Middle School participated in "Glow Day." Students collaborated to complete six challenging ELA stations that involved engaging, hands-on activities using glow in the dark products. The activities reviewed key topics taught throughout the year thus far including figurative language, signposts, genre study, parts of speech and grammar.

Chippewa Elementary School recently hosted the Journeys Into American Indian Territory for its fourth graders. Students explored all aspects of Native American life. They interacted with artifacts during a museum presentation, played traditional games and listened to stories from the Native American culture, made clay bowls and participated in a workshop focusing on the Haudenosaunee government.



The Merrimac Elementary School gymnasium transformed into the "Big Top" in collaboration with the National Circus Project. During the course of a week, fifth grade students learned the circus arts from professionals including juggling, plate-spinning, balancing and handling devil sticks. At the end of the week, the fifth graders put on a culminating show for their teachers, peers and families.

Fifth graders at Hiawatha Elementary School tapped into their brains during a special visit from Stony Brook University physician assistant students. The Stony Brook students taught the fifth graders about the basics of the nervous system and how brains communicate with the rest of the body. At the end of the presentation, students made their own brain hats.





Students at Waverly Avenue Elementary School stepped inside the world of science during an assembly called, "Spin, Pop, Boom," presented by Mad Science. Students learned all about chemistry and reactions through exciting and interactive experiments.
