Student Services

School Counseling– School Counselors are available for academic, career, individual, and crisis/intervention counseling.

Conflict Resolution - School

Counselors assist students in mediations and teaching strategies on how to resolve future problems.

Support Groups— Students meet once a week with an adult facilitator to address academic and personal/social issues. Students may self-refer or be recommended by a teacher, parent or counselor.

Multi-Tiered System of Support
