COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

ENG 1A Reading and Composition

Advisories: Ability to read at 12th grade level & GPA ≥ 2.6 . Must submit ENG clearance form to enroll | This is a transfer-level, college freshman English composition course comparable to those courses offered by the state college and university systems. (HBCU, UC, CSU, C-ID ENGL 100)

ENG 1B College Composition and Literature

Prerequisites: ENG 1A with a grade of "C" or better | This course is designed to help transfer students develop their critical thinking skills and read and write with college-level sophistication through writing analytical essays based on reading and discussing a culturally diverse literature. (HBCU, UC, CSU, C-ID ENGL 120)

HIST 17A History of the United States

Advisories: Ability to read at the 12th grade level | This course surveys US history from its pre-colonial beginnings through the Civil War and Reconstruction. Topics include geographical regions encompassed by the United States, initial cultural contact, European settlements, racial, class, religious, and gender conflicts, immigration, the development of a national identity. (HBCU, UC, CSU, C-ID HIST 130)

PSYCH 1 Introduction to Psychology

Advisories: Ability to read at 12th grade level | Psychology is the scientific study of behavior and mental processes. This course focuses on the exploration of major psychological theories and concepts, methods, and research findings in psychology. Topics include the biological bases of behavior, perception, cognition, learning, memory, emotion, motivation, personality, social psychology & psychological disorders. (UC, CSU, C-ID PSY 110)
