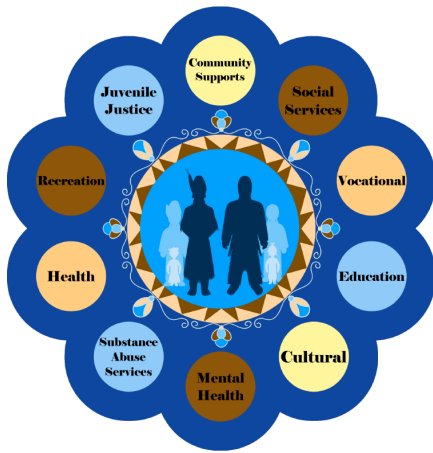

YNBHS System of Care—Wraparound

Youth/Family Driven Program

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The SOC Grant provides support services to children ages birth to 21 who are needing wraparound support services on the Yakama Reservation and surrounding communities.

Wraparound is designed to provide comprehensive behavioral health services and supports to children ages birth to 21 years of age with complex behavioral health needs and their families.

The three main components in Wraparound process are:

- Individual and Cross-System Care Plans based on strengths and needs identified by the family
- Child and Family Team is chosen by the youth & family
- Natural supports and community resources are key to the plan's success

System of Care Wraparound includes:

- Individual and Family Supports
- Care coordination
- Skill Building
- Family & Youth Peer Support
- Parenting Programs
- Cultural Supports

Wraparound Eligibility Requirements:

- Identify as American Indian/Alaska Native
- Ages 0-21 years old
- Experiencing Serious Emotional or Behavioral Challenges
- In need of or receiving services from more than one system (Child Welfare, Education, Justice Services, Mental Health, Health, Etc)
- In out-of-home placement, returning from out-of-home placement or at-risk of out-of-home placement
- Out-of-Home Placement including: Foster Placement, Juvenile Justice, Residential or inpatient, Runaway, Homeless.
- In need of youth and family skills training and therapeutic interventions
- Youth/Family would benefit from a holistic, comprehensive approach to family and youth support
