## **IMPORTANT NOTICE**

SUBJECT: **New Varicella** (Chickenpox) **immunization** requirement for entry to **preschool, kindergarten, and 6**<sup>th</sup> **grade** 

As of July 1, 2006, students entering the following grades must meet new Varicella requirements: preschool, kindergarten, and 6<sup>th</sup> grade.

According to Washington State Law, these students must have one of the following:

- 1) **one dose of Varicella** vaccine given on or after the child's 1<sup>st</sup> birthday,
- 2) Parental/Guardian **documentation of disease history** ("yes" with approximate date or age at the time of disease entered on the CIS),

Of

3) laboratory evidence of immunity to Varicella.

Proof of one of the above must be shown at the time the student registers for entry into these grades. They will not be allowed to start classes until cleared.

Please contact your clinic or doctor to arrange for your student to receive this shot. You must **show your child's immunization record as proof** of one of the above before the first day of school.

Please do not wait until August. There is always a last minute rush before school begins and appointments are often hard to get. **Remember that your student cannot begin class without these immunizations.**
