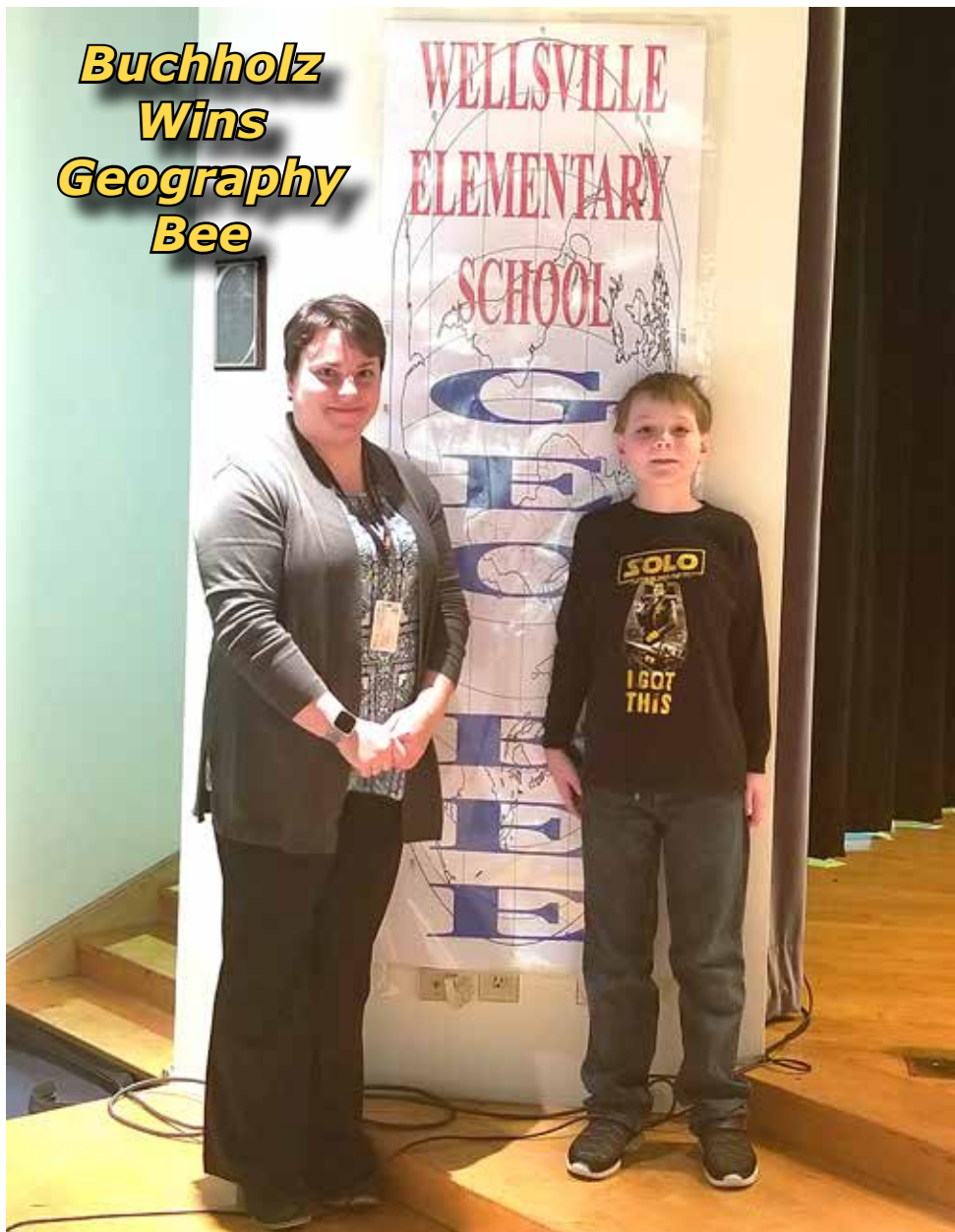

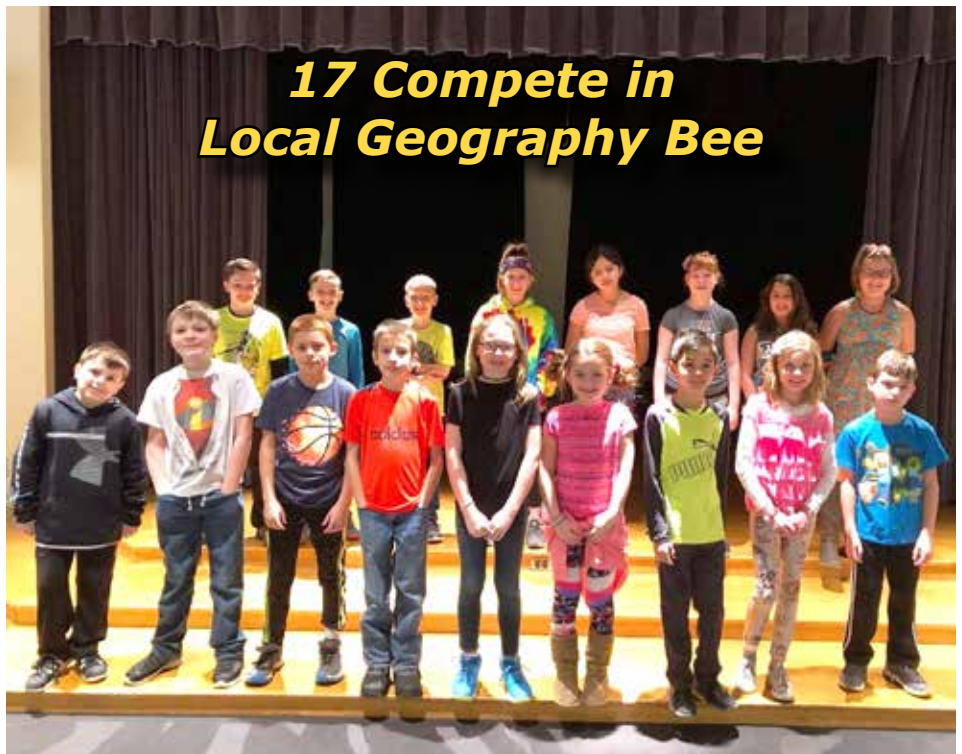

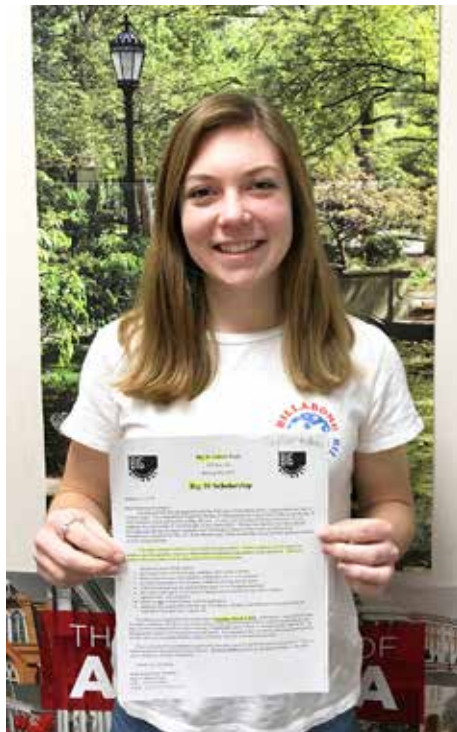


### **Juniors to Attend Boys State**

## The Great Kindness Challenge



The Wellsville Elementary School was very excited to come together and participate in The Great Kindness Challenge (TGKC) from January 28 through February 1, 2019. TGKC is a positive, proactive kindness initiative, reaching millions of students and families every year. This free program teaches so much of value to students of all ages including adults. In addition to random acts of kindness, participants are encouraged to actively seek out purposeful acts of kindness, in the hopes their efforts will have a lasting effect. This year, over 15 million students in more than 25,000 schools located in 115 countries participated in TGKC.

TGKC is an uplifting program which creates a culture of kindness in schools, communities, and the world. Using a 50-item checklist, schools and families are challenged to complete as many acts of kindness as possible. In addition to daily spirit days, students, faculty and staff also participated together in the week-long challenge by creating a chain of kindness that was revealed at the Wrap-Up assembly at the end of each week. The chain -- extending a few hundred feet long -- was a powerful tool to help students visualize the impact their actions can make. The School Edition is an annual, one-week challenge during the last week of January, and the Family Edition is something that can be done year-round.

The program has been in existence for eight years, but this is the first year Wellsville Elementary School has participated. What does this mean for your child(ren) attending the school(s) identified above?

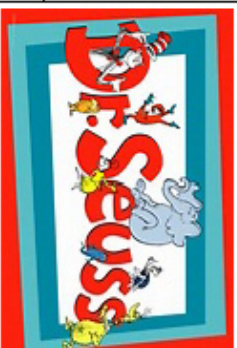
