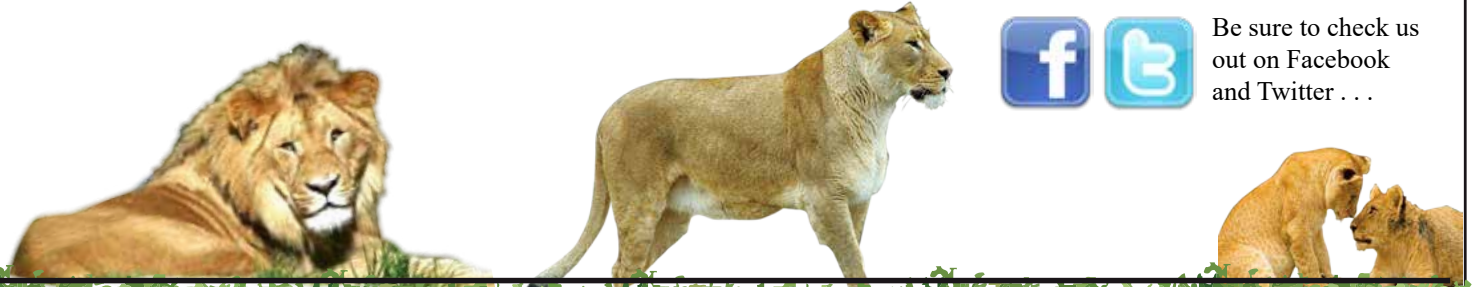

January 8 - NYS Credit Union Association Scholarship: You must be a member of ServU Federal Credit Union to apply for this scholarship. Scholarship amounts vary from \$750 to \$1,500. Applications are available in the guidance office.

January 31 - Allegany County Area Foundation Dollars for Scholars: The Allegany County Area Foundation has renewed its affiliation with the Dollars for Scholars Program. 
