For the 2023-24 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2022-23. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these labels.

West Iron County High School is the only high school in our district. Children in grades 9-12 attend the high school. We are in the second year of another cycle of our three year school improvement plan. Our School Improvement team focused on improving students' knowledge of inquiry based learning in the areas of reading, writing, math, science and social studies. The West Iron County Public Schools does not have any specialized schools. If you would like to see a copy of our curriculum, please stop in the office. Our curriculum is matched with the Common Core Standards. The M- STEP, PSAT and SAT tests are the only student normed achievement tests that we take.

2022- 24 of our 54 families were in attendance for a 45%

2021-28 of our 57 families were in attendance for a 51%

2019- 37 of our 62 families were in attendance for a 59%

# 12th Grade

2021- 16 of our 41 families were in attendance for a 39%

202-37 of our 66 families were in attendance for a 59%

2023- 21 of our 48 families were in attendance for a 44%

Students at West Iron County High School students also participated in 40 Dual Enrollment classes during the 2022-2023 school year. We had 100% success rate and the students received college credit for these classes.
