Wildorado ISD Policy for Advanced Mathematics SB2124 Advanced Mathematics

The focus for this policy is on increasing high school students' completion of advanced mathematics courses, not limited to honors or GT students. Students will automatically be enrolled in the advanced math program for 6th grade each school year, beginning in the Fall of 2024. Positive impacts include diverse classrooms and improved science performance. Determination for participation in 6th-grade advanced math may include the top 40% from 5th-grade STAAR scores or the top 40% from 5th grade math coursework.

Students who are not being successful in the program will attend required intervention with differentiated and scaffolded instruction to suit the individual needs of the student. If the student is still not being successful in the advanced math course, a committee (including the parent, teacher, and administrator) will meet to determine the next steps for math instruction placement.

Wildorado will make public the criteria for automatic enrollment in the advanced math program before the start of each school year. Wildorado will provide written notice to the parent or guardian of each grade 6 student who will be automatically enrolled in an advanced math program no later than 14 days before the first day of instruction for the school year. Parents may choose to opt out of their child out of the program. Please contact the campus for more information.
