

Board Vacancy

The Willsboro Central School District has an opening for a seat on its Board of Education from January 1, 2020 until June 30, 2020.

Interested individuals should submit a written response to the following questions:

1. Why are you interested in serving on the Board of Education?
2. What life experiences do you have which qualify you for service on the Board of Education?
3. What is your view of what the role of a school board member is?

Written responses should be submitted to the District Clerk, Brandy Pierce Nolette, by December 23, 2019, by e-mail at bpierce@willsborocsd.org or mail (Willsboro Central School District, PO Box 180, Willsboro, NY 12996).

It is anticipated that a candidate will be appointed by majority vote of the Board of Education on January 14, 2020.

Residency in the Town of Essex and prior board experience are preferred but not required qualifications.

Qualifications for Member of the Board of Education

- Must be able to read and write.
- Must be a qualified voter of the district; that is, a citizen of the United States, at least 18 years of age or older, and not adjudged to be an incompetent.
- Must be and have been a resident (but need not be a taxpayer) of the district for a continuous and uninterrupted period of at least one year.
- May not have been removed from any school district office within the preceding year.
- May not reside with another member of the same school board as a member of the same family.
- May not be a current employee of the school district.
- May not simultaneously hold another incompatible public office.
