- I spend my time on the things that are the most important.







Listen before you speak

Find Your Voice


- I have found something that I am good at and really like doing.

- 45 minutes in Reading each week













My Word Study Book 1 Grade 3




Word Study Practice Texts Grade 3




To practice reading unknown and difficult words by breaking them into parts and looking for context clues.


- Welcome: background information on my teaching experience

Math Curriculum


Students in grades K-2 are using the new Florida B.E.S.T. Standards, while students in grade 3-5 are transitioning to the new standards this year.


Our math curriculum, Ready Classroom Mathematics correlates with iReady.

We use both the online component as well as the student workbooks.






Studies Weekly is our Social Studies Curriculum.


