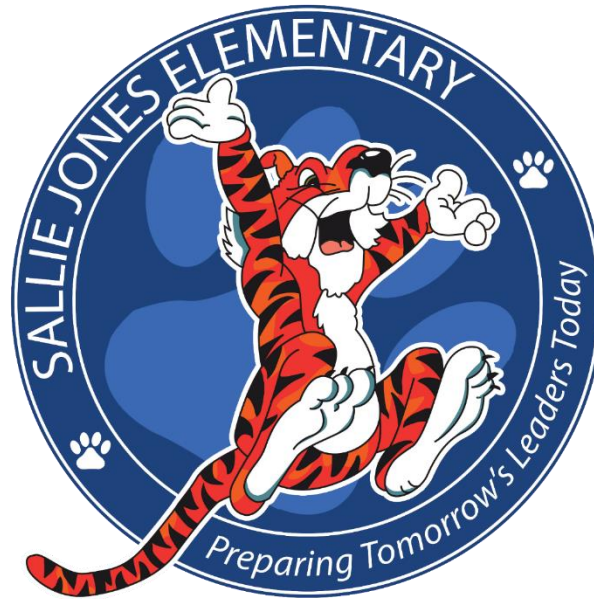

- ❖ Provides supplemental learning materials.

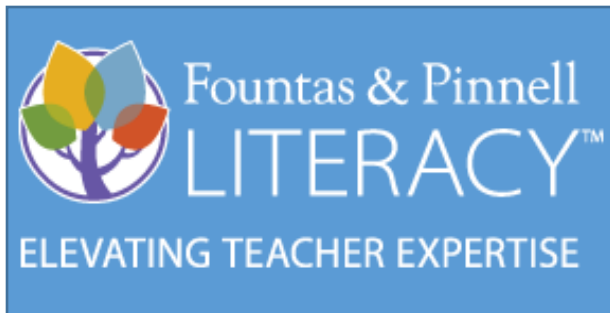

We use **Remind** for important school & district messages.



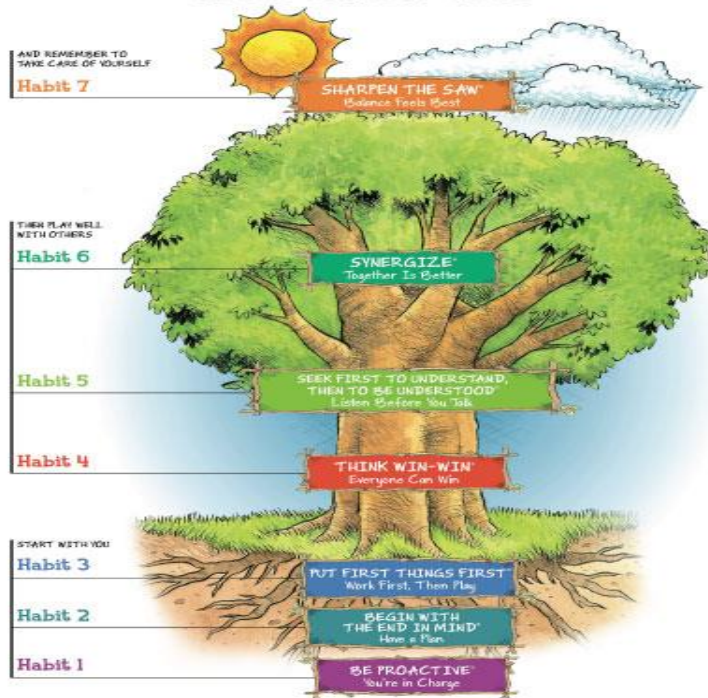
I use **ClassDojo** for our class. Go ahead & download it so we can keep in touch this year.

The 7 Habits[®] Tree



Habit #1

BE PROACTIVE

You're in charge of yourself

- I have a "can do" attitude and always try my best at everything I do.
- I follow directions and do the right things without being asked, even when nobody is looking.
- I choose my actions, attitudes, and moods and don't blame others for my wrongdoing.



Habit #2

BEGIN WITH THE END IN MIND

Have a Plan

- I plan ahead and set goals for myself.
- I am prepared at all times.
- I think about how the choices I make now will affect my future
- I think about the positive or negative consequences of my actions before I act.



Habit #3

PUT FIRST THINGS FIRST

Work first, then play

- I do the things that I have to do before I do the things that I want to do.
- I stay focused on what I'm doing. I try to minimize distractions and regroup if I get off task.
- I spend my time on the things that are the most important.



Habit #4

THINK WIN WIN

Everybody can win!

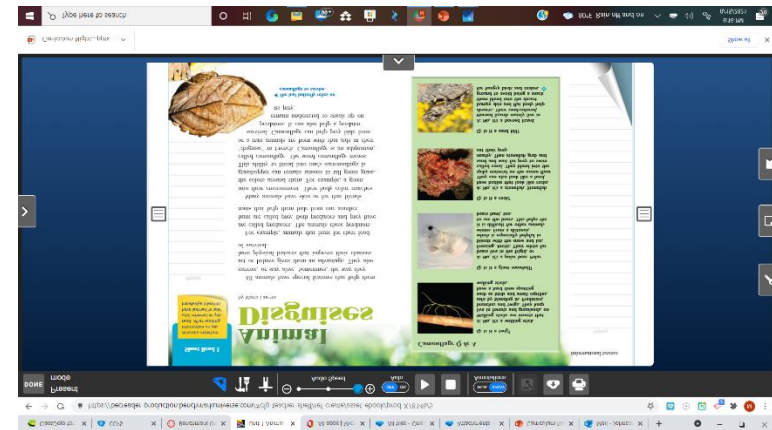
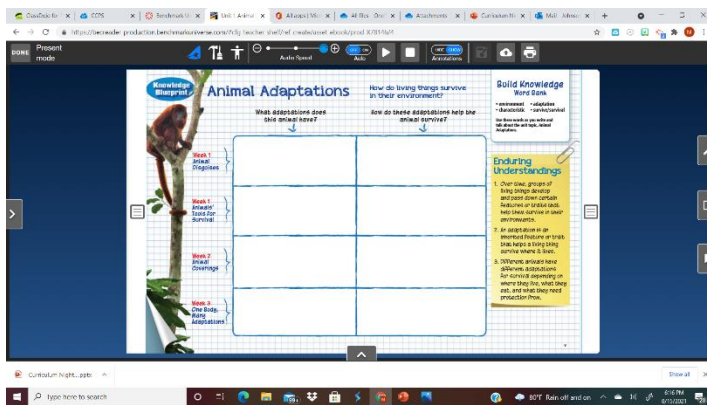
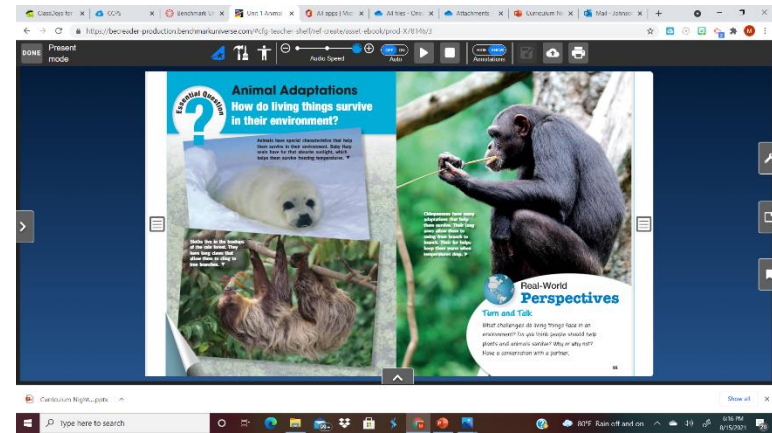
Reading Curriculum

All students in grades K-5 are using the new Florida Benchmark for Excellent Student Thinking aka Florida B.E.S.T. Standards.

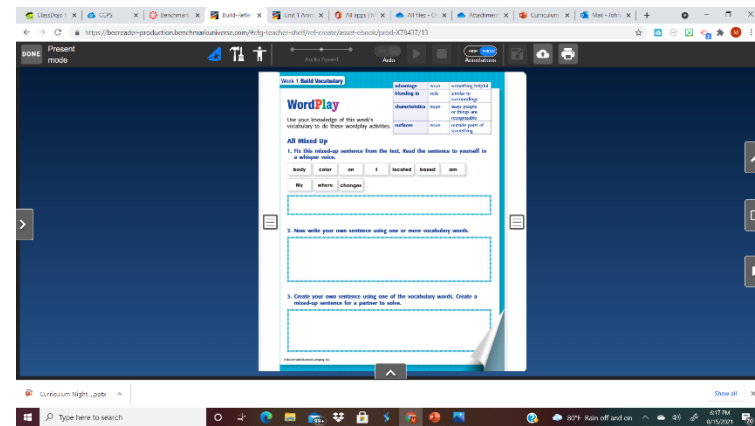
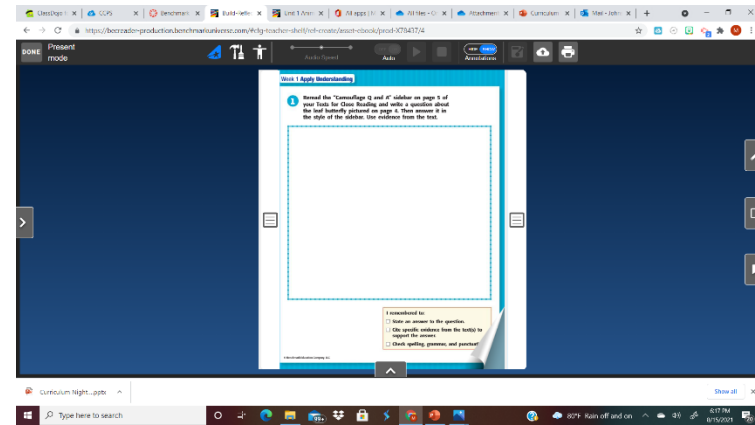
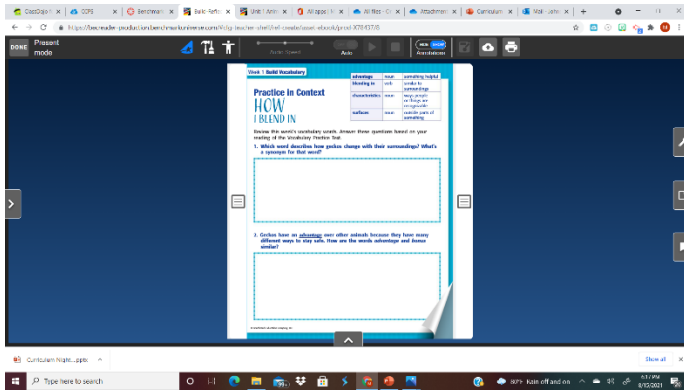
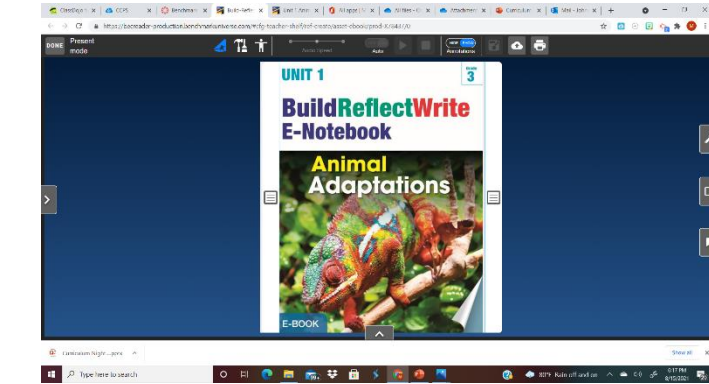

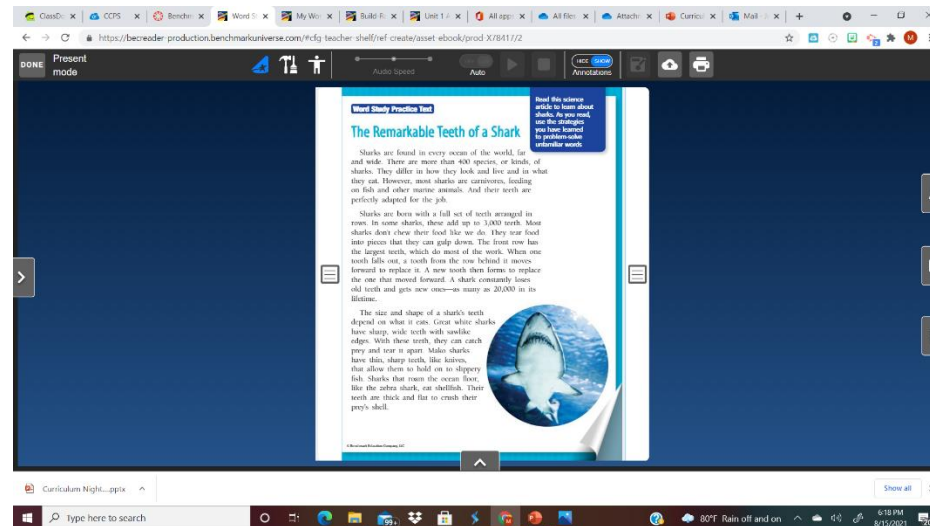
To practice fluency (the ability to read with speed, accuracy, and proper expression.)

To practice reading unknown and difficult words by breaking them into parts and looking for context clues.

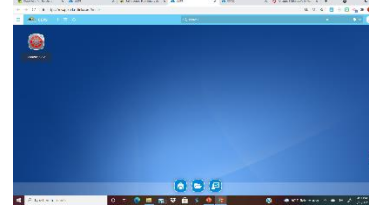

What else can you find on Mrs. Johnson's Teacher Page?

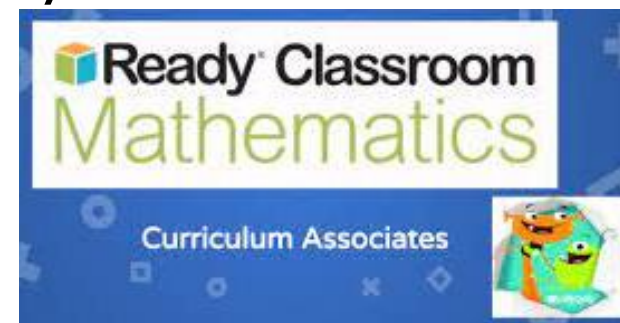
- **Welcome:** background information on my teaching experience

Math Curriculum

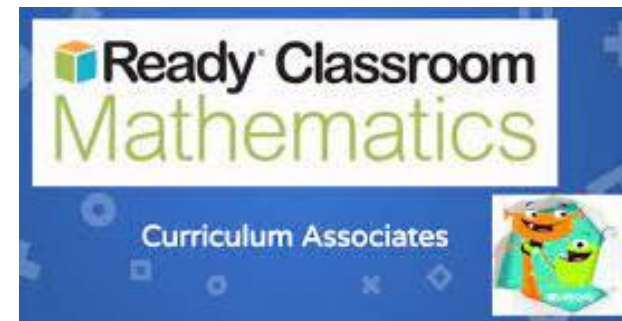
Students in grades K-2 are using the new Florida B.E.S.T. Standards, while students in grade 3-5 are transitioning to the new standards this year.

Our math curriculum, Ready Classroom Mathematics correlates with iReady.



The Comon Core State Standards

- The focus is on **Critical-Thinking, Problem-Solving, Analytical Skills.**

 - 1) **Operations and Algebraic Thinking**
 - 2) **Number and Operations in Base Ten**
 - 3) **Numbers and Operations- Fractions**
 - 4) **Measurement and Data**
 - 5) **Geometry**



Science Curriculum

Elevate Science is our Science Curriculum.

The standards are Next Generation Sunshine State Standards aka NGSSS.

We use both the online component as well as the student workbooks.

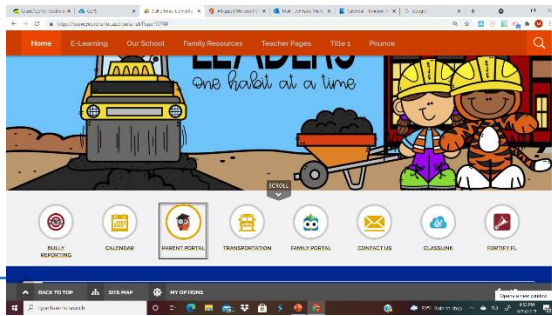
