## Native American Literature: The FIRST American Literature

-- Challenging, for two reasons:

- 1) Many Tribes, many languages-- (name some)
  ex: "Windtalkers" movie
- 2) No universal alphabet, therefore stories not written down "Oral Tradition"

stories don't remain consistent

However, Native stories (literature) <u>did</u> influence later American writers...

**Oral Tradition** 

**Mythic stories (fantasy)** 

--As in other cultures, Native American culture is rich in <u>myths</u> and <u>legends</u> that were used to explain natural phenomena that is hard to understand. Some common myths explain Earth's creation. Others explain the sun, moon, animals, seasons, weather, etc.

Native American Myth: "Man in the Moon"

--What natural phenomena is explained in this myth?

--How easy would this story be to remember?

(Oral Tradition of storytelling)
