Professional Learning Certification Program 24-25

The CCPS Professional Learning Certification Program (PLCP) is for teachers who:

- Hold a temporary teaching certificate, expiring no earlier than June 30, 2026
- Are employed as a full-time classroom teacher in a public or charter school
- Need education hours to meet Statement of Eligibility (SOE) requirements
