# **Charlotte County Public Schools Florida Prepaid Scholarship**

In partnership with the Florida Prepaid College Program, Charlotte County Public Schools will award a one **2-Year Florida College Plan Scholarship** valued at \$8,000 to an 11<sup>th</sup> grade student in the District.

A Florida Prepaid 2-Year Florida College Plan covers tuition and other specified fees at any of 28 Florida public colleges for 60 credit hours.

#### Overview:

Designed to encourage CCPS students considering education as a career path to enter college upon high school graduation, the goal of the scholarship is to bring CCPS graduates back "home" to teach in one of the District's schools.

The winner of this scholarship must meet the basic requirements to hold a Prepaid Plan and will be required to submit the Master Contract and agree to be bound by the terms and conditions therein.

#### Key Criteria:

\*Required criteria (\*must meet the general requirements of a Prepaid Plan):

- \*11<sup>th</sup> grade student in the 2022-2023 school year (*Scholarship to be presented to recipient during the Underclassmen Award Ceremony*)
- \*Documentation of Florida Residency
- \*Social Security #
- Considering a career in education, grades PreK-12
- GPA Requirement: 3.0 cumulative unweighted, or higher
- Community Service Hours: Minimum, 25 hours
- Personal Statement: Why are you considering a career in education, and what do you consider the most important quality of a teacher? 500 words max
- Letter of Recommendation (1) from School Principal, Assistant Principal, Counselor, or Teacher
- School Involvement: List of extracurricular activities
