

QUIZZES & TESTS

During the school year, there will be several major unit tests and smaller quizzes to track your learning.

On each quiz, you will be asked to complete multiple problems (with all work shown) similar to bell-work. Some quizzes throughout the year may be open note but not all of them. If you don't bring your binder to class, you will be responsible to take quiz without your materials.

You will have a unit test for each unit we cover this year. On tests you will not be able to use your binder but you will be provided with the state assessment reference sheet.

If a student is absent the day of a quiz or test, they will have to reschedule to make-up the assessment. Failure to make-up the assessment will result in a zero.
