AMH 2010 is the history of the United States to 1865. This course is a survey of U.S. history from settlement until the Civil War. The emphasis of the course will be on the development of American social, political, and economic institutions; problems of the new government; Jacksonian Democracy; territorial expansion and the coming of the Civil War.
