Neil Armstrong's Mentor Program was established to give our intermediate students the opportunity to grow as leaders and to support our younger students with academic and/or social needs.

Mentor Responsibilities

- Mentors meet with their mentee three times daily:
 - ~ after a.m. duty, or before 8:55 a.m.
 - ~ after lunch
 - ~ before p.m. duty, or before 2:50 p.m.
- Mentors meet with the mentee's classroom teacher at least once a week to discuss mentee's progress
- Mentors work with the mentee to build positive academic and/or social skills
- Mentors work with the mentee's classroom teacher to determine when the mentee will be rewarded for progress being made
- Mentors keep grades up and complete homework at all times
- Mentors lead by example at all times
