



### Reading: Additional Expectations

We expect the students at this level:

to have the ability and the desire to think deeply about literature and informational texts

liking)

#### This is not a place for:


- A reluctant writer

We have expectations for:

- Polished presentations
- A willingness to "stretch" and take chances
- A number of solo and group presentations requiring at-home preparation

- Reading large sections of novels or plays
- Reading challenging nonfiction selections
- Following strict timelines for projects
