FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK...

C.W Baker High Students, Staff, and Families,

Student 3rd quarter interim reports were published in Schooltool today, so be sure to check grades and comments and reach out if you or your student needs any assistance. We will also be sending out support letters to families of any struggling students next week. There is still time to seek assistance and get any support needed to finish out the school year successfully!

I also wanted to make you aware of an announcement I made to students this afternoon, following a bathroom vandalism incident that caused some flooding in a hallway and a couple of classrooms today. We are having some overcrowding and vaping issues in our restrooms between periods and during passing time and starting next week, we intend to close restrooms between periods/during passing time, to assist with our monitoring of restroom use. Single use restrooms and the nurse's office will always be available for emergencies, but the expectation until further notice, is that students use Smartpass to sign out to restrooms during class periods. This will help us to monitor the number of students visiting restrooms at the same time, as we work to curb vaping and vandalism.

I acknowledged to our students that we appreciate them all and feel that we have a great student body, made up of outstanding kids that are working hard and doing the right things. That being said, we must acknowledge that some students are as frustrated with vaping in restrooms as staff, and we must continue to work together to curb negative behaviors that also pose health risks to our kids. We will continue to clarify expectations to students and as always, please reach out if you have any questions or concerns. I left the students today with this message, I appreciate our staff, students, and families, but we all need to have an expectation that we will respect one another and the resources that our community provides us. 


