We could not be more proud of our student athletes closing out this fall sports season. Our boys' soccer team lost a heartbreaker this Sunday afternoon, but fought hard to the very end. Girls' volleyball also had an outstanding showing at the regional final, but showed what BEES are all about. And our boys and girls Cross Country runners wrapped up an outstanding season at the state meet at VVS. Our Orchestra and Concert band had first concerts of the season and were absolutely impressive. The fall has been so busy for our kids, but what they have experienced and what we have witnessed is greatness!

As we close out the first quarter and proceed into the very busy holiday season, I want to remind everyone to stay connected. Continue to communicate with teachers and coaches, reach out to counselors when necessary, and keeping checking in with your students. We completed our BIMAS survey with all grade levels this past week and our next round of teen Mental Health First Aid is November 13th and 14th. The topic is Helping a Friend in Crisis-Suicide. The session will provide support for students confronted with friends having difficulties and experiencing suicidal thoughts. Trained staff will guide students through what they can do to reach out for assistance when experiencing these feelings or when they see friends struggle.
