Student Drivers: Parking for students is by permit only. Please review all of the parking requirements [here](#). Registration for any Juniors or Seniors is now open.



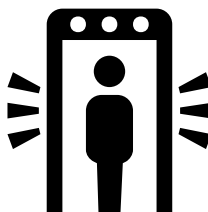

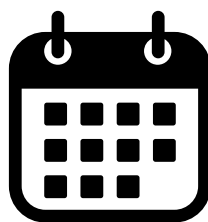
SmartPass: We have implemented a fully digital student pass system. Rather than paper passes, staff will be using a digital sign out system throughout the building. We will also schedule student passes for early dismissals and counseling meetings.

Weapons Detection Systems: We plan to implement our new Weapons Detection Systems (metal detectors) by the end of the month. We will notify students and parents via email and text message prior to them being officially operational. Safety and security for our students, staff, and families is our top priority and we appreciate your support as we implement these additional tools to protect our school community.

LATE ENTRY AND EARLY DISMISSAL FOR SENIORS

This year, as a privilege for our senior students, we will be offering the opportunity for seniors to come in for 2nd period or leave after 8th period.

In order to apply for an Late Entry/Early Dismissal pass, students must qualify according to the following criteria:

- ✓ Must have 1st or 9th period study hall
- ✓ Must be a senior in good academic and behavioral standing.
- ✓ Must have passed ALL REQUIRED Regents Exams for graduation.
- ✓ Students or their parents/guardians are responsible for transportation if arriving late or leaving early.
