Attendance

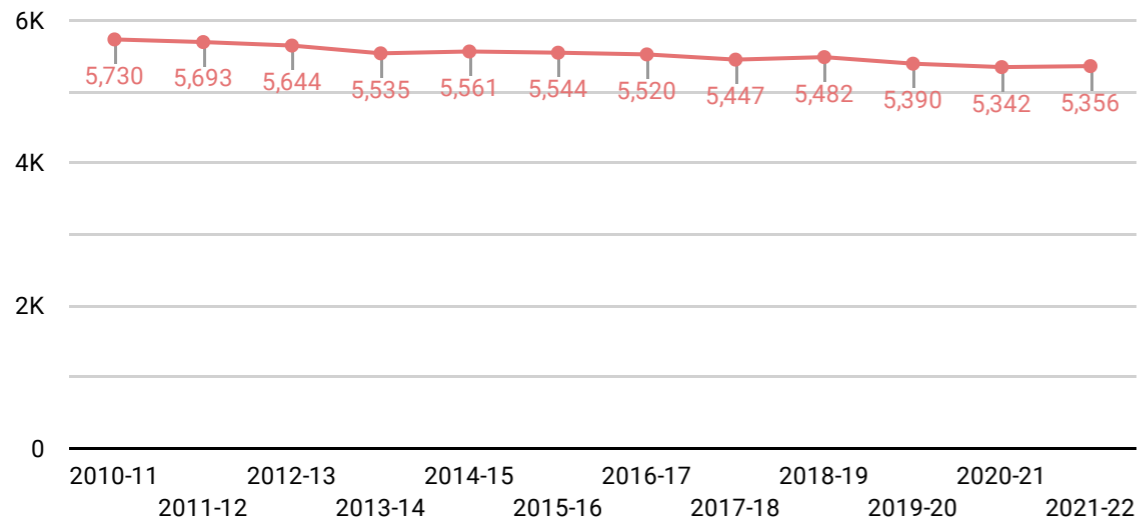
Students have been present in-person over 90% of instructional days.



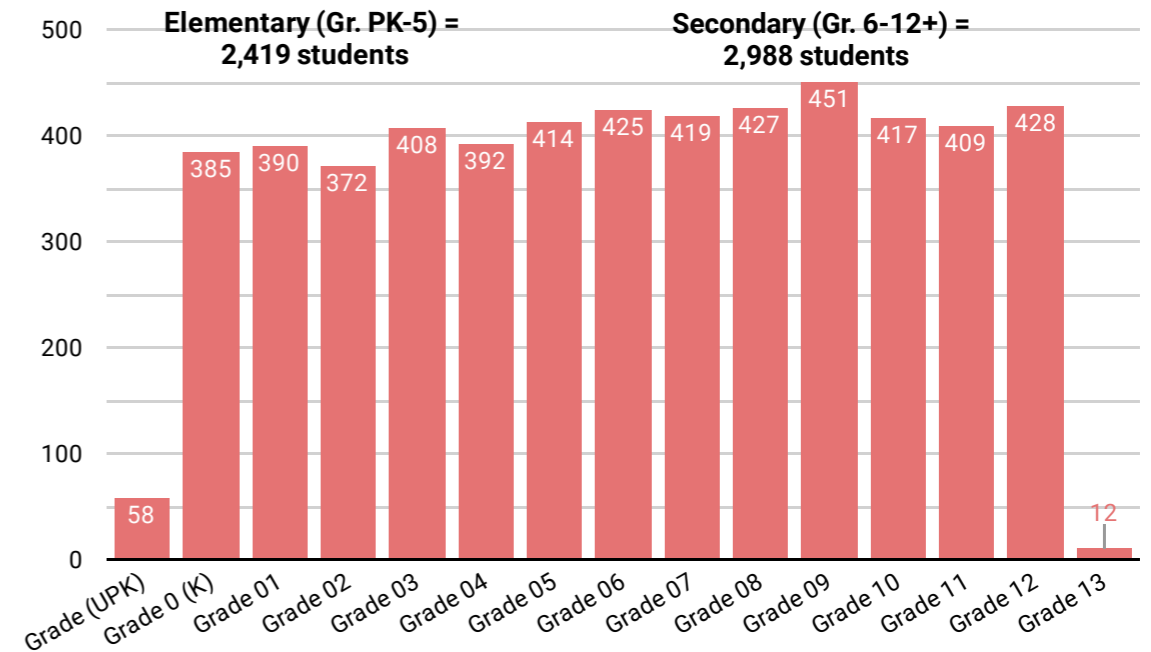
COVID-19 Impact

An average of 14 positive cases per day have been reported this quarter district-wide.

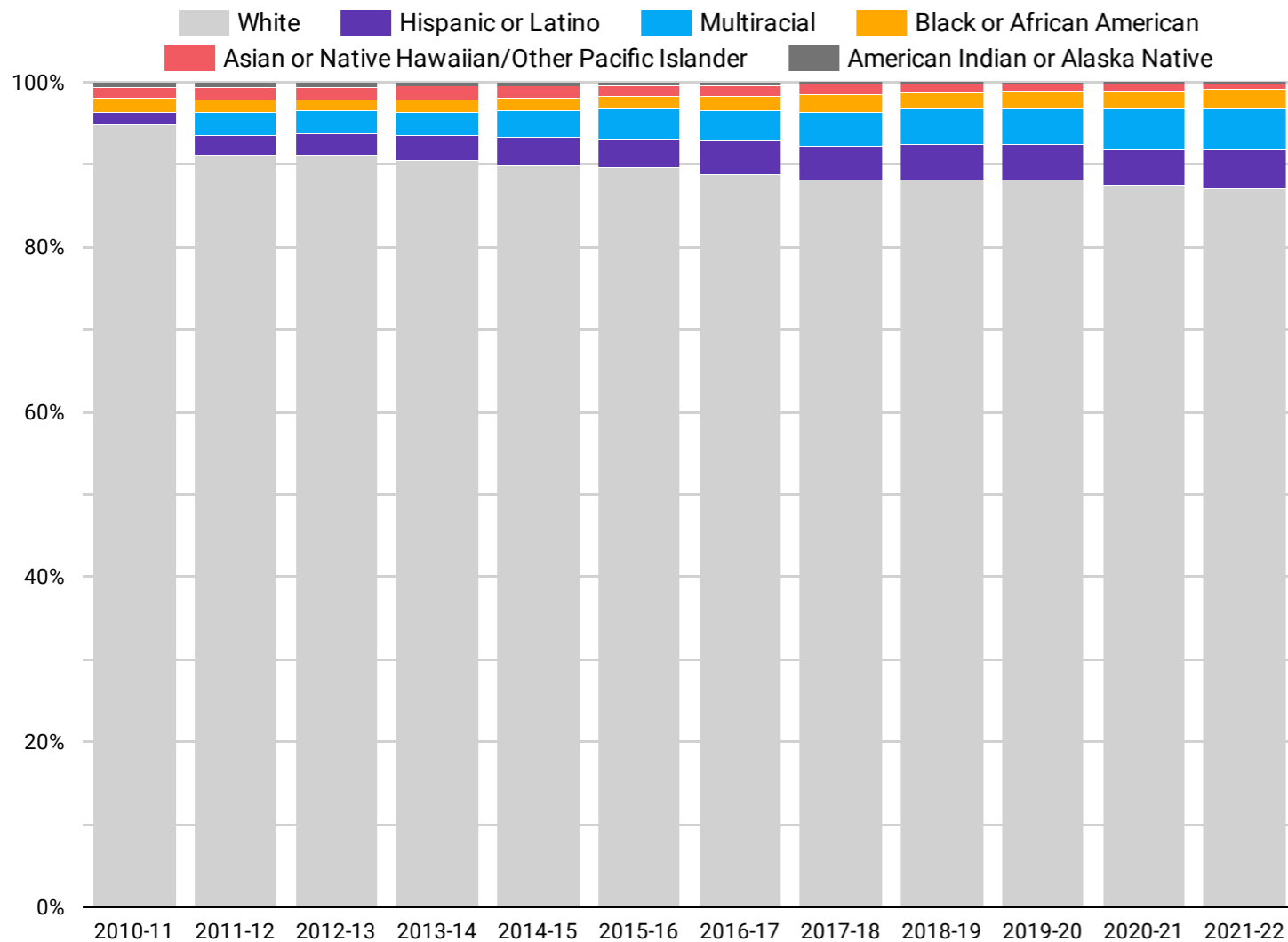
Enrollment trend over the last 10 years

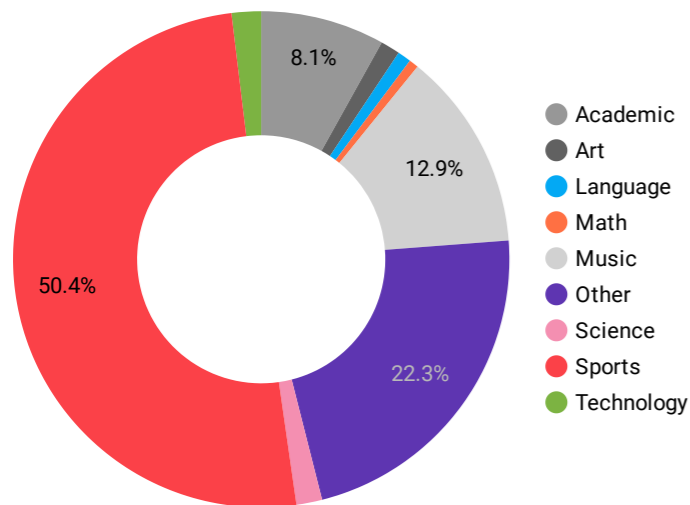

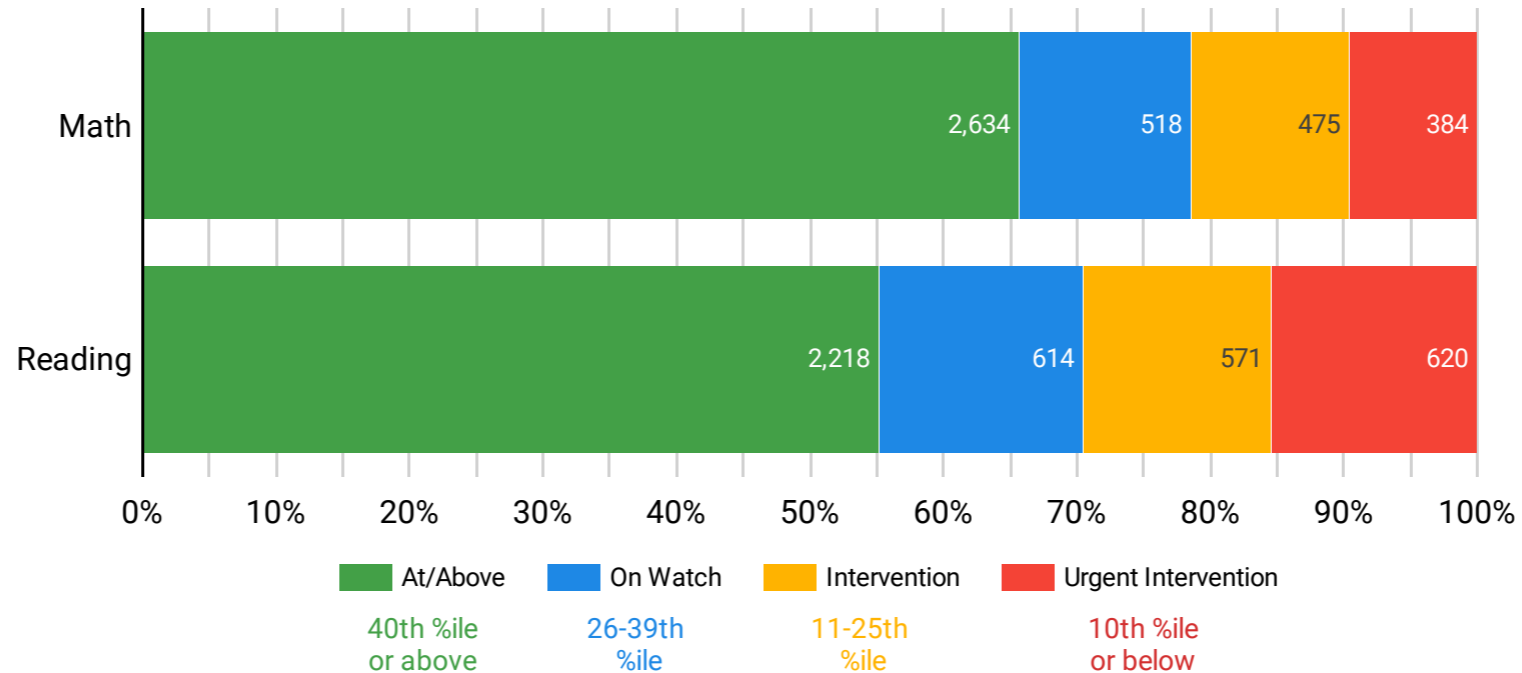

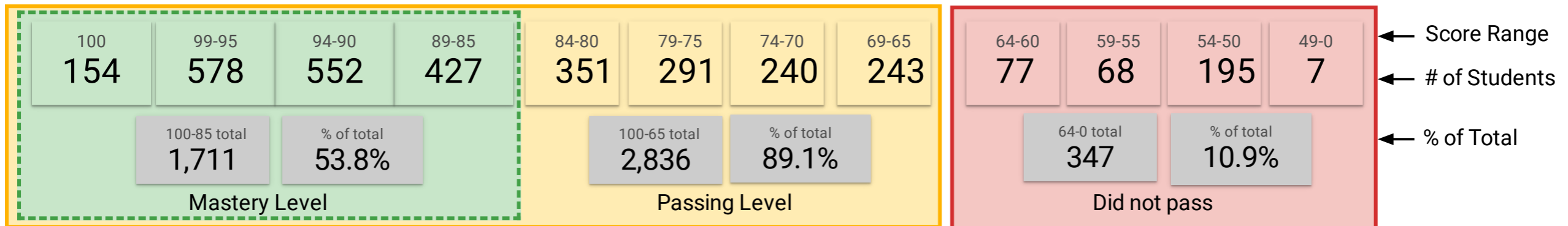

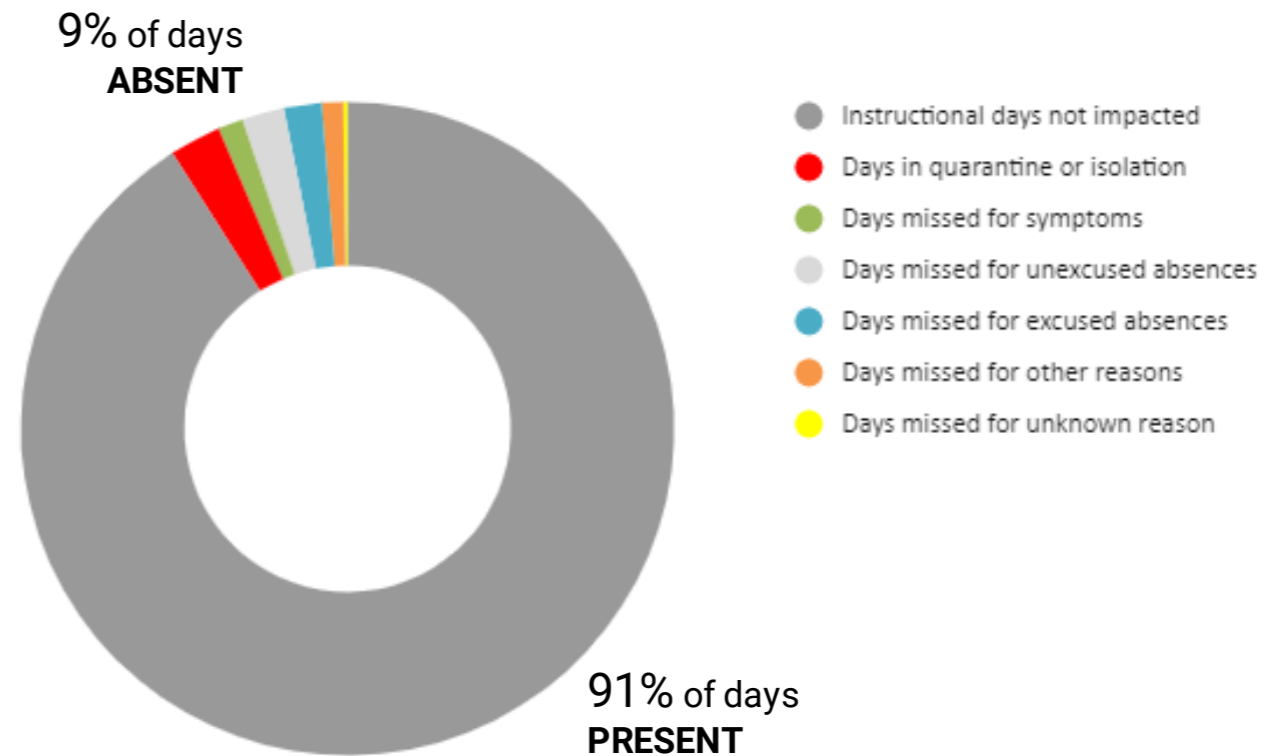

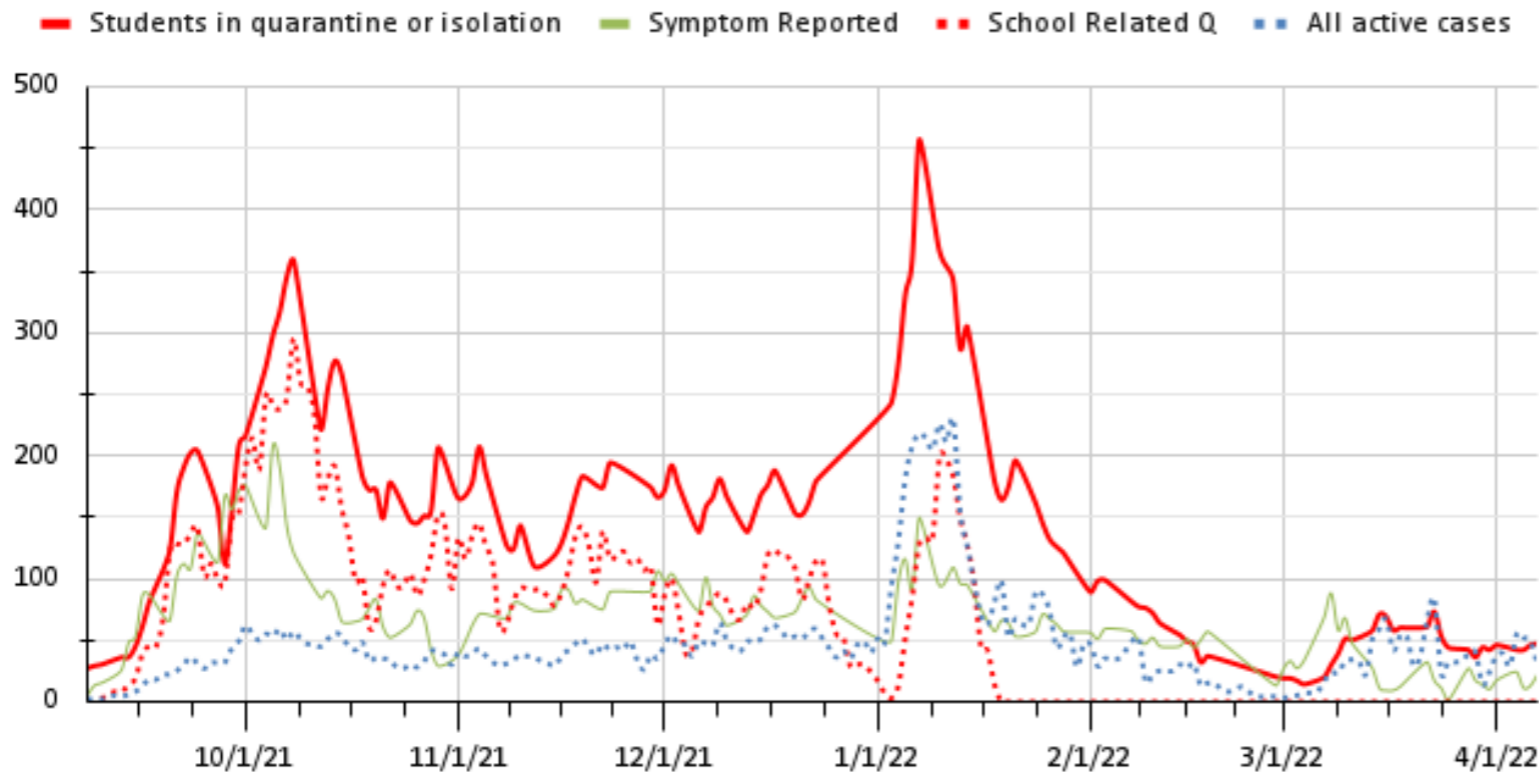
