### **Attendance**

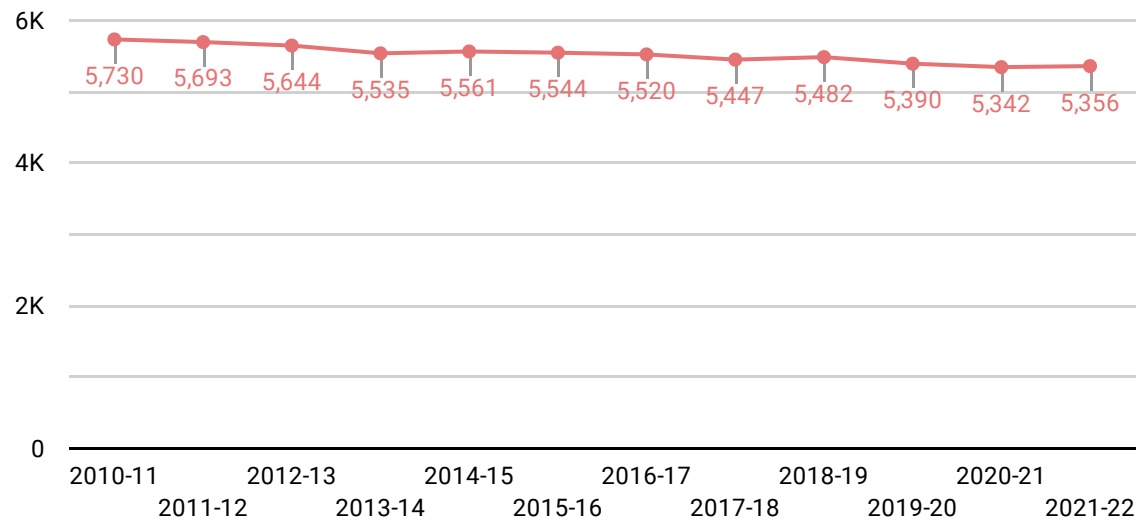
Students have been present in-person over 90% of instructional days.



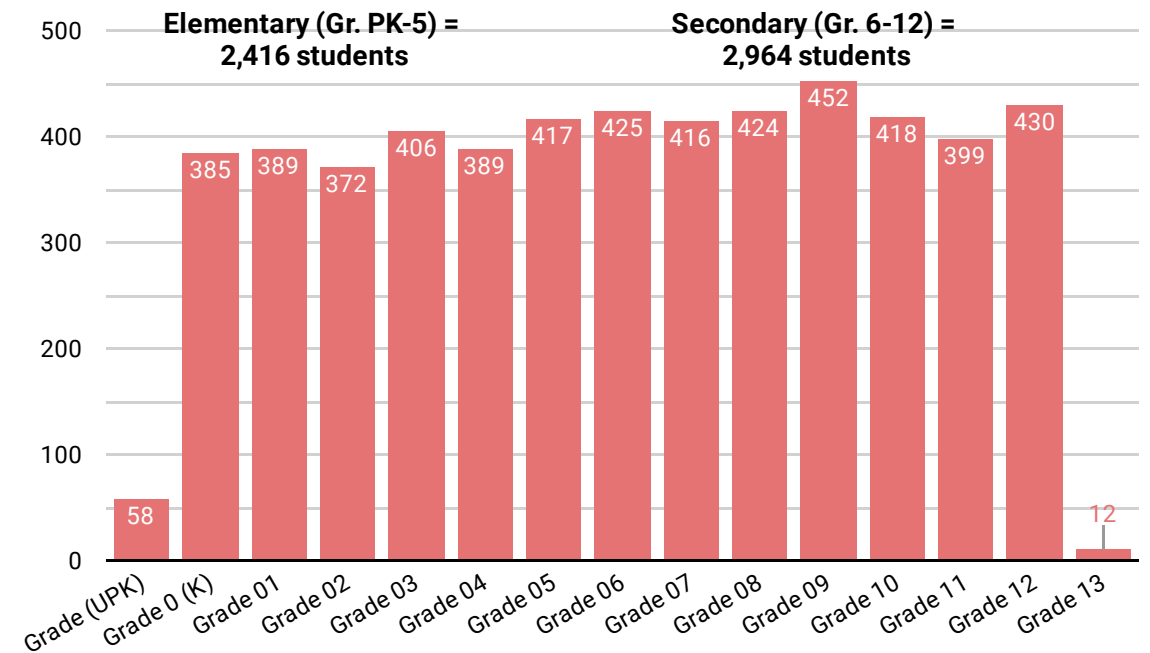
### **COVID-19 Impact**

An average of 6 positive cases per day have been reported this quarter district-wide.

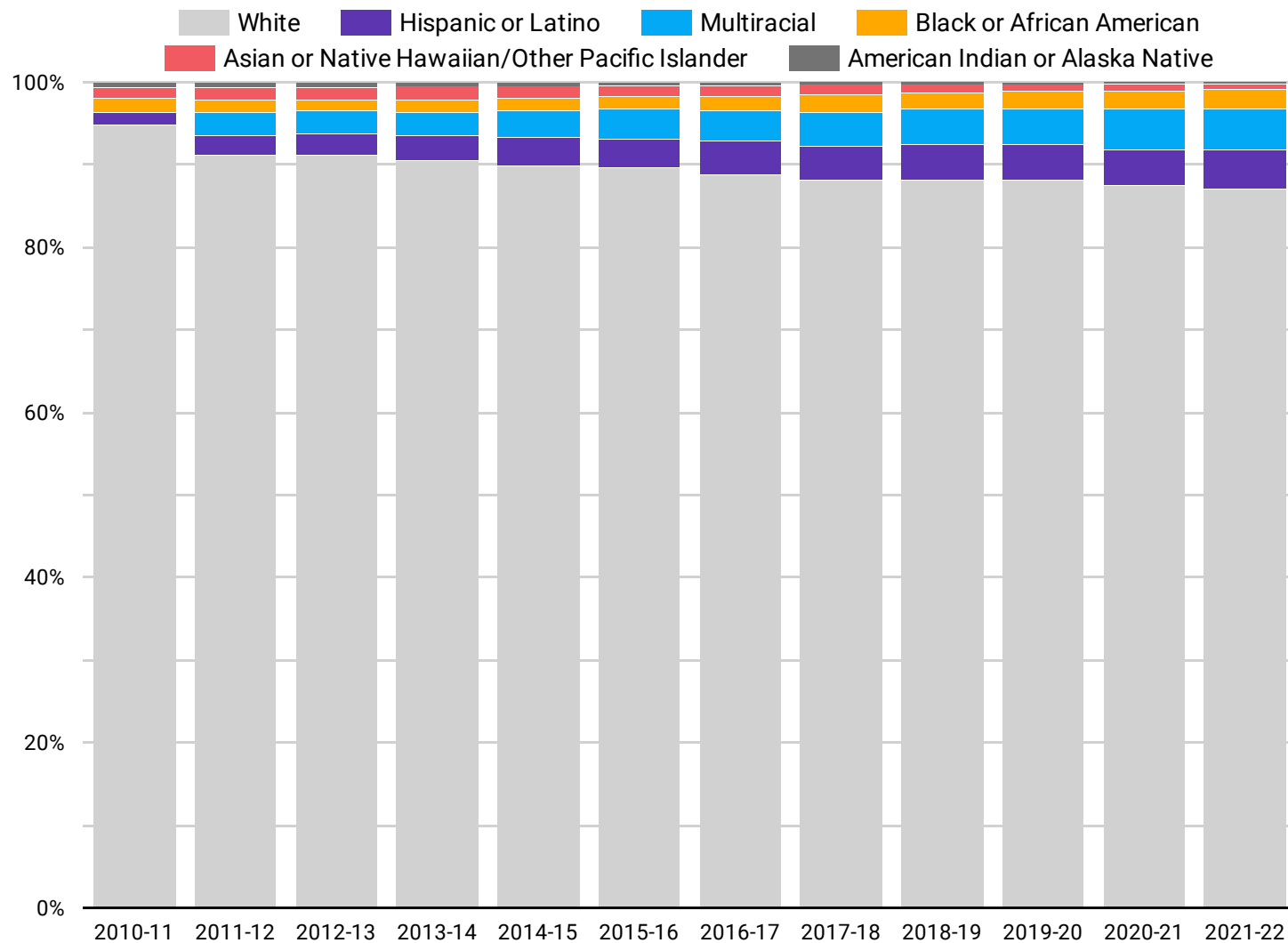
Enrollment trend over the last 10 years

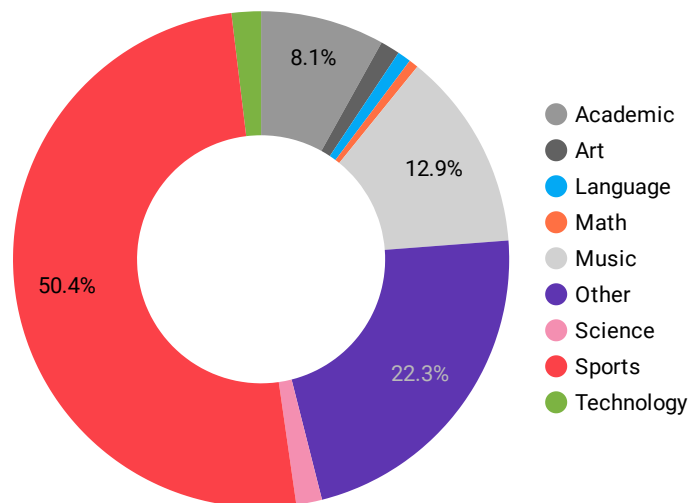

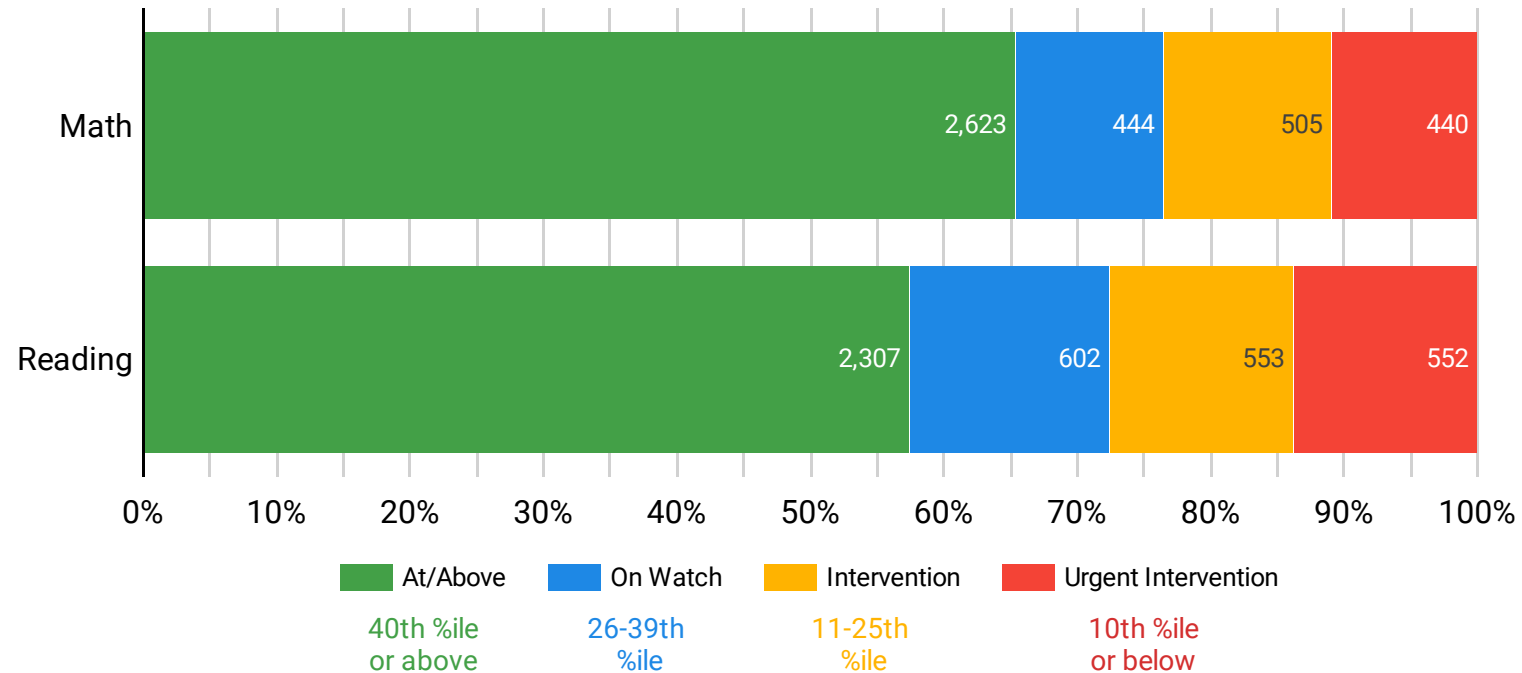

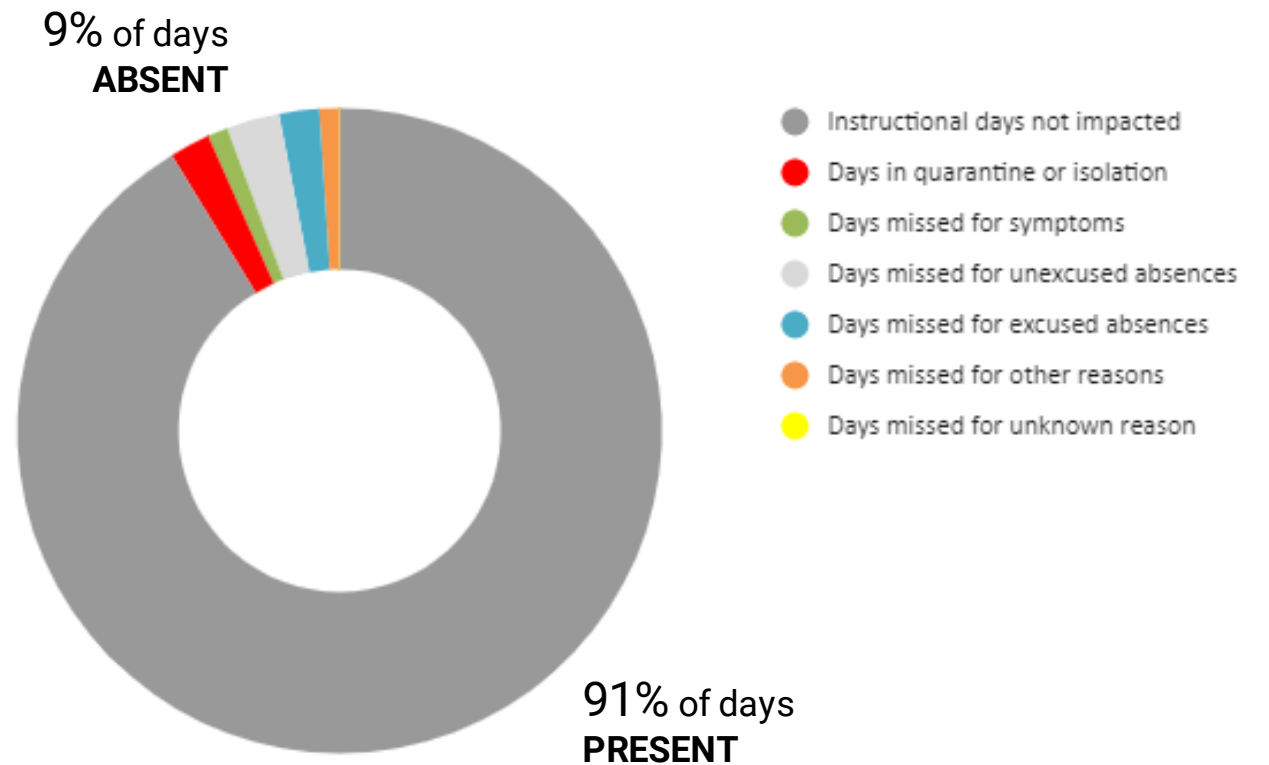

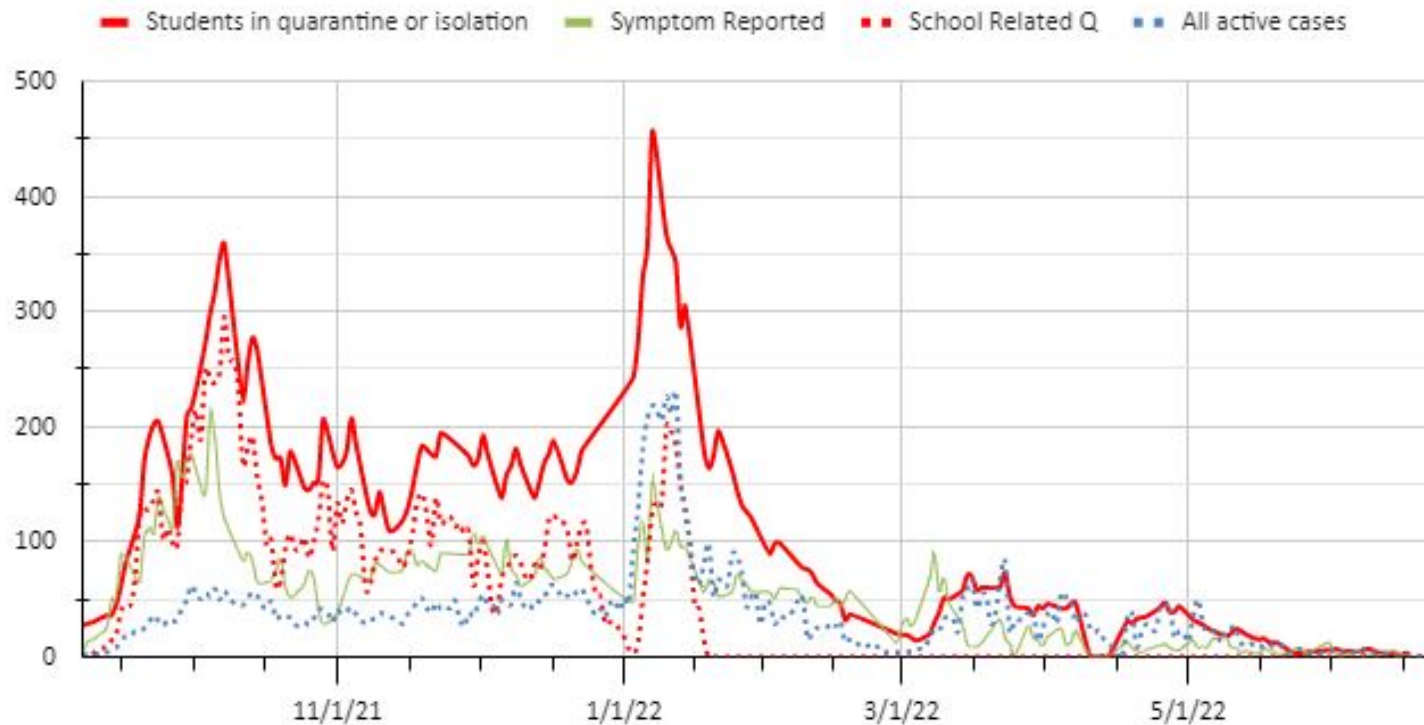
