• Per SED, the estimated inflation rate is 3.9%, which would likely apply to most of these *low impact items*

- We do <u>not</u> know if the Foundation Aid Formula will change, these estimates are based on *Current Law* and are subject to change
- * These noted items are expense-based aids and could be adjusted for 2022-23 actual spending
- Hopeful to see the Executive Budget by the end of this month
