Voters can vote in-person or request an absentee ballot application. Absentee Ballot applications can be obtained from the District Clerk in the District Office, 16 Fravor Rd. Suite A, Mexico, NY 13114. Qualified voters may obtain applications for absentee ballots from the office of the Clerk. Completed absentee ballots applications must be received by the District Clerk of the School District no later than 4 p.m. prevailing time, on May 15, 2023, and must be received no later than 4 p.m., prevailing time, on May 9, 2023, if the absentee ballot is to be mailed to the voter. Completed applications received after 4 p.m. on May 9, 2023, require the voter to personally appear at the Office of the Clerk of the School District for their ballot. If there is a qualified voter that is not registered with Oswego County Board of Elections or has not voted in an annual or special school election in the last four years, contact the District Clerk Harmony M.
