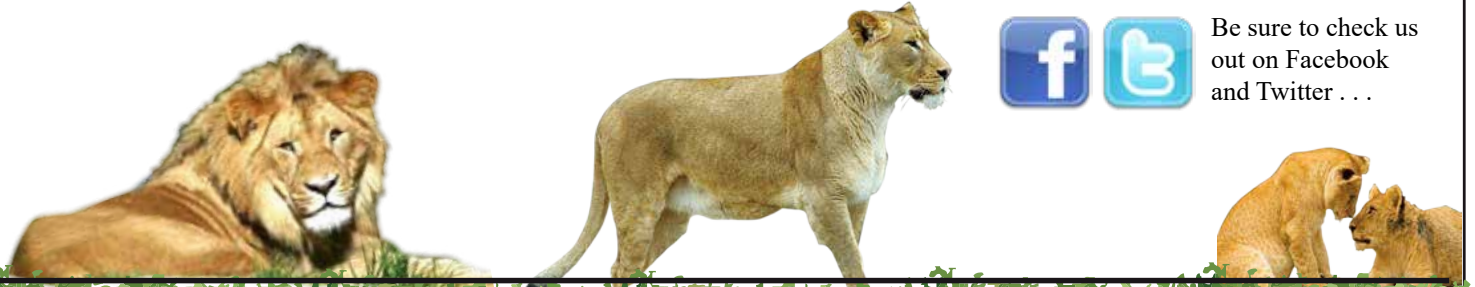

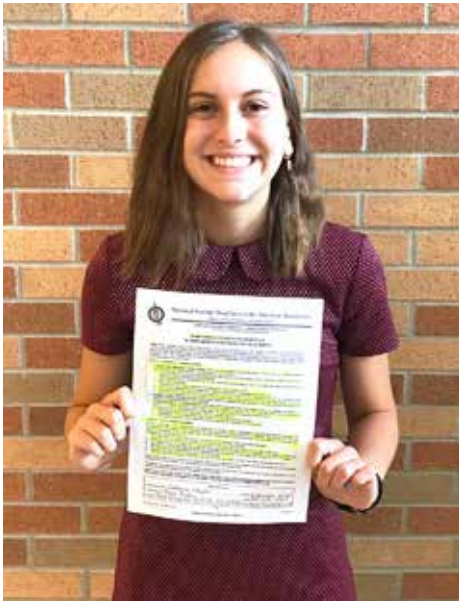

5th Grade Science Experiments



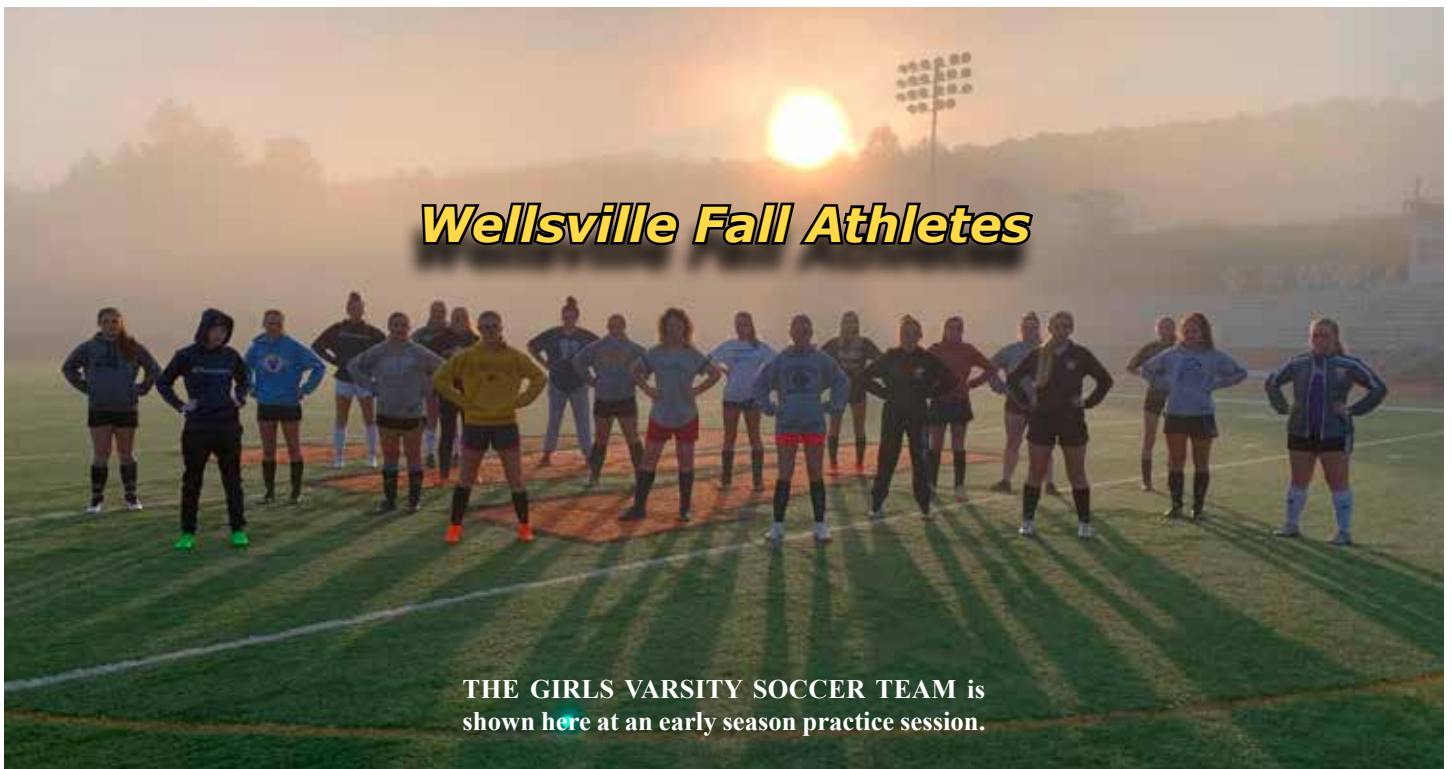

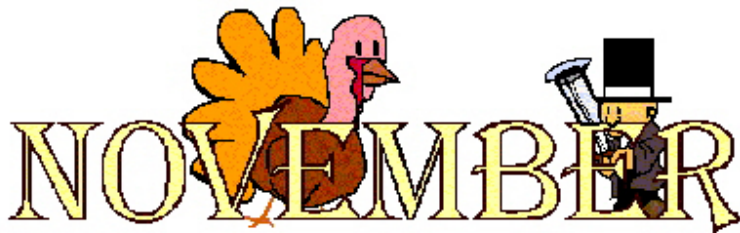
