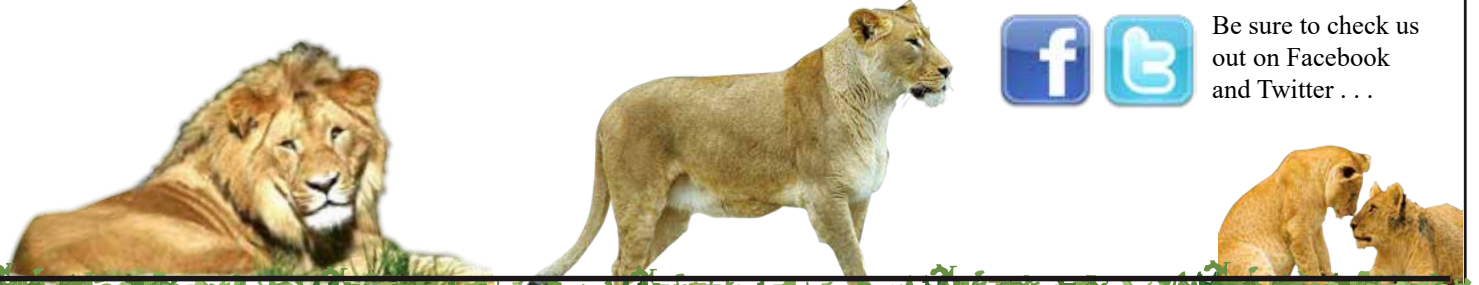

Attention Seniors

Please bring a copy of your college acceptance letters and scholarship offers to the guidance office. If you have not yet completed your college application, see your counselor for assistance.

Students and parents should apply for financial aid as soon as possible. You must complete and submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to be eligible to receive federal student aid. The FAFSA is also required for most state and institutional financial aid opportunities. Financial aid offices use information from the FAFSA to determine if you are eligible to receive federal student aid from grants, loans and work-study programs. You may file your FAFSA electronically at www.fafsa.ed.gov.

Class of 2021 Scholarship Deadlines

The following scholarship opportunities are now available:

January 8 - NYS Credit Union Association Scholarship: You must be a member of ServU Federal Credit Union to apply for this scholarship. Scholarship amounts vary from \$750 to \$1,500. Applications are available in the guidance office.

January 31 - Allegany County Area Foundation Dollars for Scholars: The Allegany County Area Foundation has renewed its affiliation with the Dollars for Scholars Program. February 1 - Young Women in Public Affairs Award

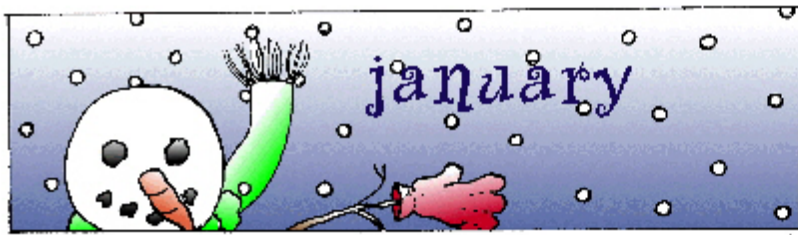
