ELL Checklist

Create a Welcoming Environment
Learn about your ELL student- (country of origin, has there been trauma?, educational background or experiences, screening level, test scores)
Partner ELL with another student for a personal connection (classroom procedures)
Find ways to communicate (visuals, translations, kinesthetic learning)
Role – play instructions- use manipulatives
Track what the child can do – use this for grading- not what the child can't do.
Learn the alphabet
Learn Fry Words
Use ELL apps on ClassLink (Duolingo for English, Glossaries, ELL Activities)
Strategies for ELLS:

- o Physical involvement with language,
- Use multiple mediums to present information,
- Find opportunities to demonstrate language comprehension through physical expression,
- o Create a low-stress environment for language performance,
- o Success can be independent of language performance,
- Try to have a large amount of interactions with other students
- o Check into after school tutoring
- o Communicate with parents suggesting pre reading activities
