Featured Grade Levels



Second graders are working on identifying explaining theme, retelling a literary text using main story elements and identifying different character's perspectives. Students are making text connections, using background knowledge to determine meaning and learning the features of poetry.



Third graders are working on explaining how characters and theme develop through a plot. Students are identifying an author's claim and explaining how text evidence supports the author's claim.

Fun Activities for Home For Featured Grade Levels:

2nd Grade- Reading-Help your child with drawing inferences to build knowledge using the books your child is reading at home. Act as a "detective" while reading together, use what you know and evidence from text to "read between the lines" to figure out what the author is saying.

Math-Practice adding and subtracting 3 digit numbers. Roll a Number Sentence: Your child will roll three numbers and used them to make two different 3-digit numbers (largest number possible and smallest number possible). Then, they add those numbers together. Try this with subtraction too!

3rd Grade- Reading-Allow your child to express their opinions on the stories/books your child is reading and defend their interpretations. Ask your child to show/explain the text evidence that shows the author's message/claim.
