

CLASSROOM RULES AND EXPECTED BEHAVIOR

Mr. Hayse's Classes

-Students tardy 4 or more times (counting any period) will be subject to the discipline code.

3. Remain in your seat unless given permission to do otherwise.

-Students wishing to sharpen pencils or obtain materials in the room should obtain permission (raise your hand).

4. Raise your hand to get assistance, ask questions, or contribute to the class discussion.

-In NO case should students interrupt the teacher or another student while he or she is speaking. Such behavior is rude and will not be tolerated.

5. Use the restroom and get your water before class.

-Plan your day. Use the restroom before school, between classes, before or after P.E. or at lunch.

-Emergencies are understandable, but make requests infrequently.

6. No eating, drinking, or candy will be permitted in the classroom.

-This is a school rule, All candy should be consumed elsewhere.

-Mind your own business. If another student is breaking a rule it is the teacher's concern.
