# Deciding on Childcare...

There's a public school-based program for YOUR family!

The Charlotte County Public Schools Early Childhood Programs aim to meet the needs of each individual child and family. As they seek to prepare their children for kindergarten and beyond, parents and caregivers work together with program staff to reach their specific goals. A variety of program options, calendars and ancillary services are available in school district facilities countywide.

Depending on the circumstances and needs of each, families may consider enrolling children in Head Start, Early Head Start, VPK, Teen Parent Program childcare, traditional (tuition) childcare or if the child has been identified with a disability, the Pre-K Exceptional Student Education Program. While each program meets the needs of specific populations of children, many services are blended, allowing the strengths of each to benefit all. Some programs are free of charge, some require weekly tuition payments; some run through the summer, others do not. While the location of a classroom or program may vary, the quality and range of services will not.
