V. Classroom Policies and Expectations

VI. Student Chromebook Use and Expectations

- Chromebooks stay in the classroom. Only use your assigned Chromebook.
- Only use a school approved background. Profile image may be a picture of yourself or an avatar.
- Use your school email only.
- Only use your Chromebook in the classroom when instructed to use it.
- Do not visit pages or documents that are not directly related to your assignment.
- Web browsing is for educational/school use only.
- School-approved games are allowed when teacher has given permission to play.
