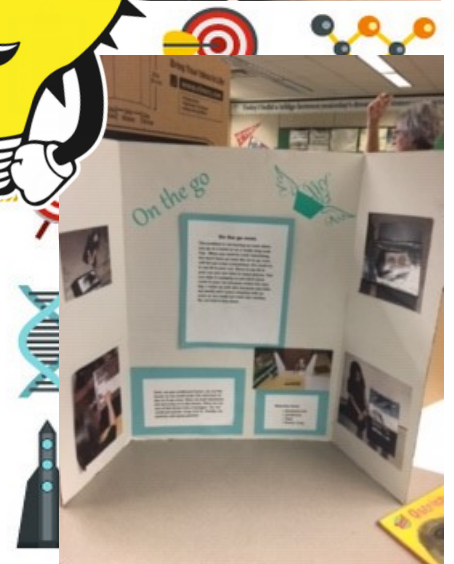
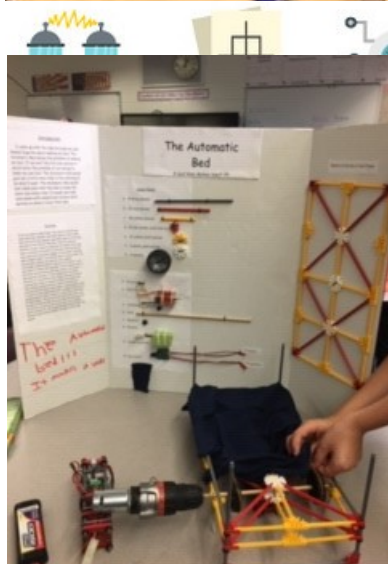
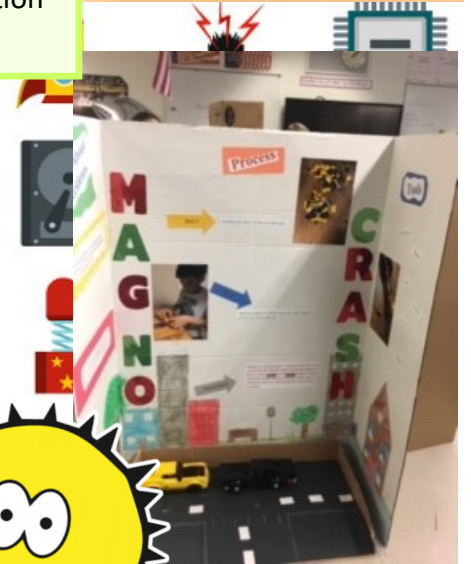
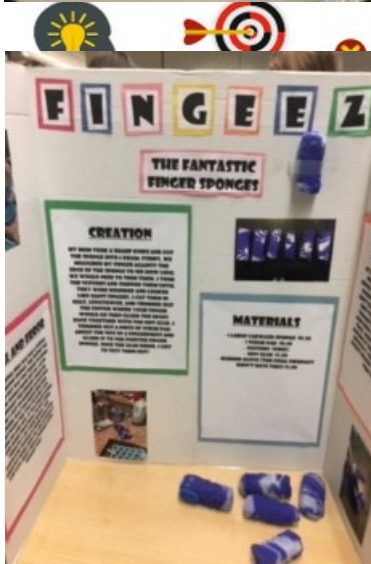
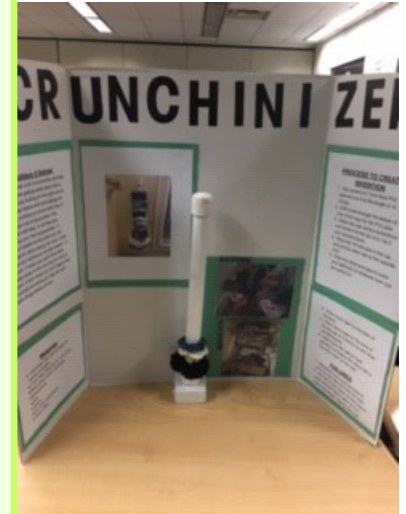
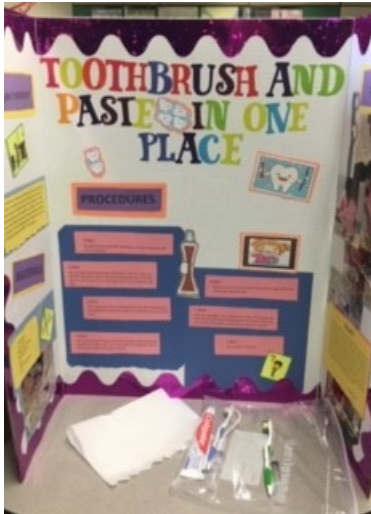


Fifth Grade Invention Convention

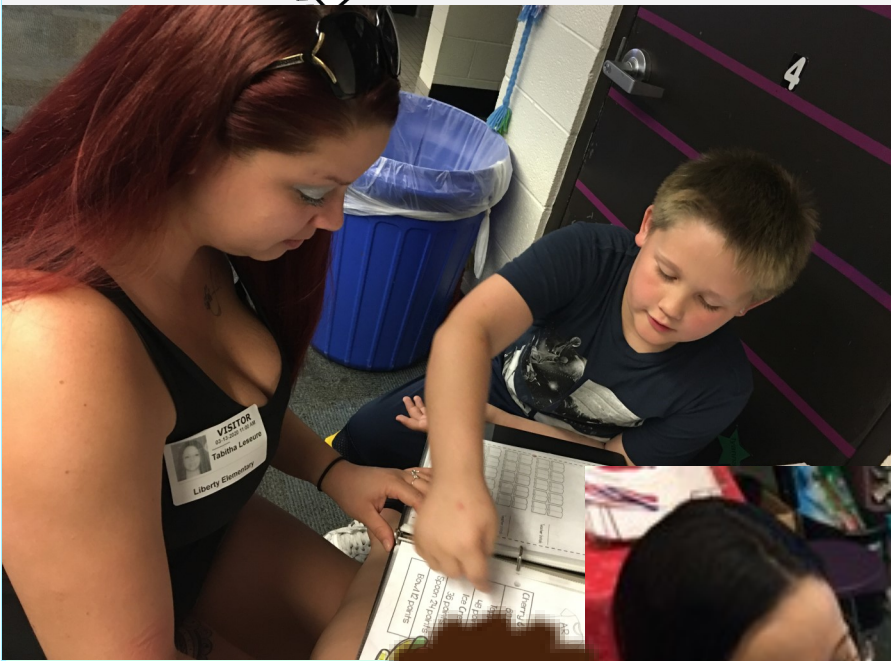


Mrs. Hill's amazing first grade class decided that there was too much litter on their school campus so they decided to clean it up! Way to go kids!!!!



Mrs. Hill's met class their AR goals and celebrated with ice cream sandwiches! Yum!

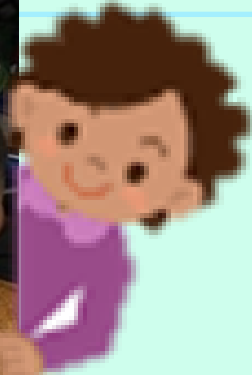
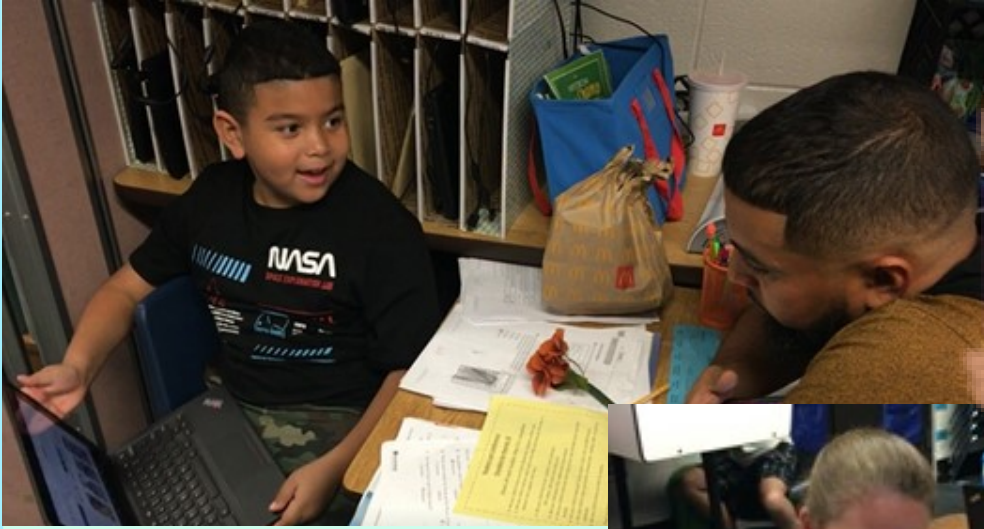
Student Led Conferences
